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1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Beats Studio Pro are wireless Bluetooth noise-cancelling headphones designed to deliver a rich, immersive audio experience. Featuring Personalized Spatial Audio, USB-C Lossless Audio, and compatibility with both Apple and Android devices, these headphones offer up to 40 hours of battery life and advanced noise control for an unparalleled listening experience.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

3. SETUP

3.1 Charging Your Headphones

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your Beats Studio Pro headphones. Use the provided Universal USB-C charging cable to connect the headphones to a power source (e.g., a USB wall adapter or computer USB port).

- The LED indicator lights on the headphones will show the charging status.
- A 10-minute Fast Fuel charge provides up to 4 hours of additional playback when the battery is low.

Lossless Audio via USB-C

3.2 Pairing with Your Device

Beats Studio Pro headphones offer enhanced compatibility with one-touch pairing for both Apple and Android devices.

1. **Power On:** Press and hold the power button on the right earcup until the indicator lights illuminate.
2. **Enter Pairing Mode:** Continue holding the power button for a few seconds until the indicator lights begin to pulse, indicating pairing mode.
3. **Connect:**

- **For Apple Devices:** Bring the headphones near your unlocked iPhone/iPad. A pop-up will appear on your device screen. Follow the on-screen instructions to connect.
- **For Android Devices:** Open your device's Bluetooth settings. Select "Beats Studio Pro" from the list of available devices.
- **For Other Devices:** Ensure your device's Bluetooth is enabled and search for "Beats Studio Pro" in the Bluetooth settings.

4. **Confirmation:** The indicator lights on the headphones will turn solid white when successfully paired.

4. OPERATING YOUR HEADPHONES

4.1 On-Device Controls

The multi-function on-ear controls allow you to manage calls, control music playback, and activate voice assistants.

- **"b" Button (Left Earcup):**

- Press once: Play/Pause, Answer/End Call
- Press twice: Skip Forward
- Press three times: Skip Backward
- Press and hold: Activate Voice Assistant (Siri, Google Assistant)

- **Volume Rocker (Left Earcup):**

- Press top: Volume Up
- Press bottom: Volume Down

- **Mode Button (Right Earcup):**

- Press once: Toggle between Active Noise Cancelling (ANC) and Transparency mode.

4.2 Active Noise Cancelling (ANC) and Transparency Mode

Beats Studio Pro offers two distinct listening modes to control your audio environment:

- **Active Noise Cancelling (ANC):** This mode uses advanced algorithms to block out external noise, providing an immersive listening experience. Ideal for travel or noisy environments.
- **Transparency Mode:** This mode allows you to hear your surroundings while still enjoying your audio. It's useful for staying aware of your environment, such as when walking in a city or needing to hear announcements.

Toggle between these modes using the Mode button on the right earcup.

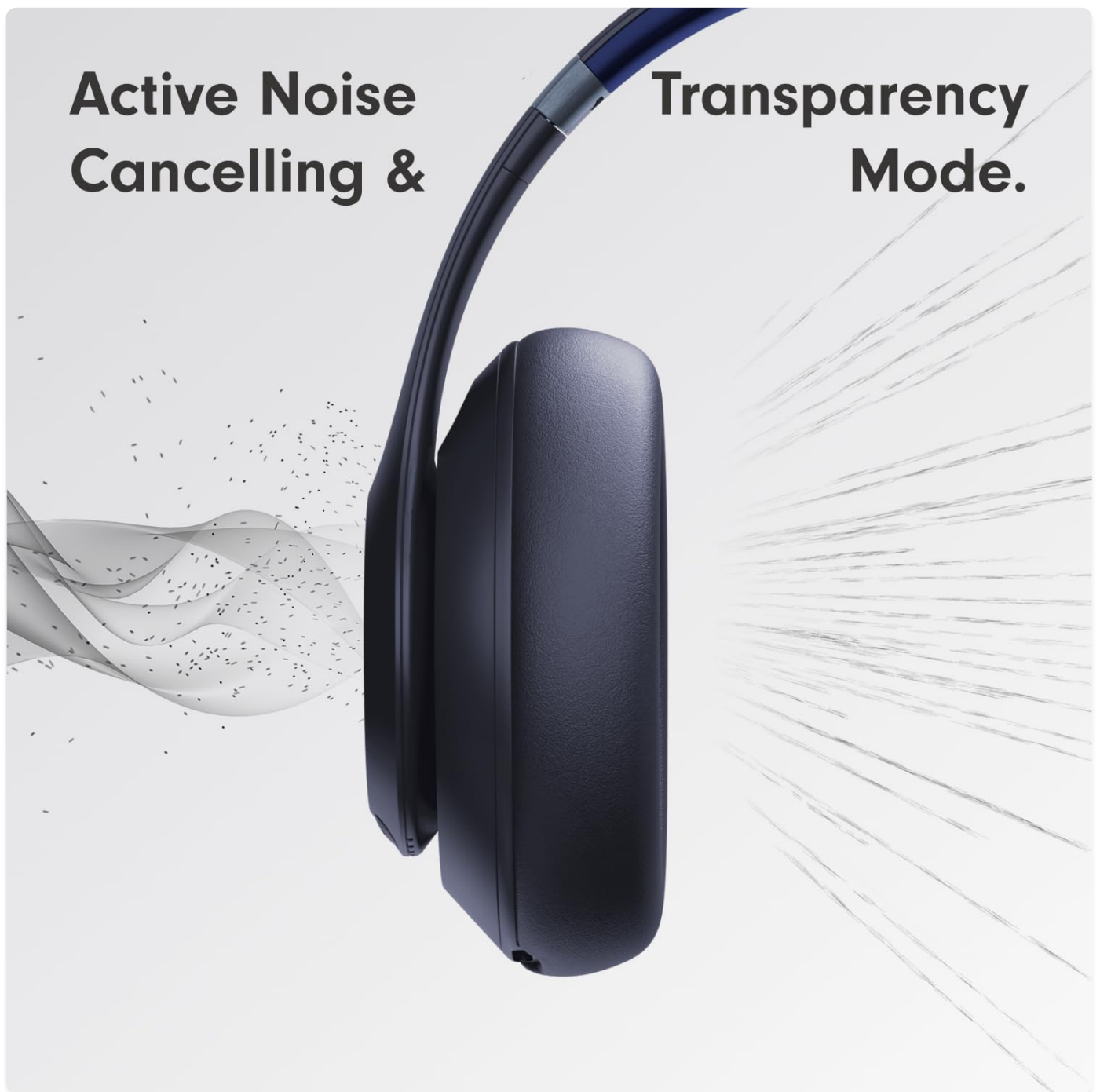

4.3 Personalized Spatial Audio

Experience an immersive 360-degree listening environment with Personalized Spatial Audio and dynamic head tracking. This feature places you at the center of the sound, making music and movies feel more lifelike. This feature is available with compatible content and devices.

4.4 USB-C Lossless Audio

For the highest fidelity audio, connect your Beats Studio Pro to a compatible audio source using the provided USB-C cable. This connection enables lossless audio playback, preserving the full detail and quality of your music. The headphones also feature three distinct built-in sound profiles to enhance your listening experience when using USB-C audio.

4.5 Call Performance

The voice-targeting microphones precisely filter background noise, ensuring crisp and clear call performance even in noisy environments.

4.6 Battery Life

Enjoy extended listening sessions with up to 40 hours of total battery life. Actual battery life may vary based on usage, settings, and environmental factors.

Testing conducted by Apple in May 2023 using preproduction Beats Studio Pro units and software paired with iPhone 13 units and prerelease software. The playlist consisted of 358 unique audio tracks purchased from the iTunes Store (256-Kbps AAC encoding). Volume was set to 50% and Active Noise Cancellation and Transparency were turned off. Testing consisted of full Beats Studio Pro battery discharge while playing audio until Beats Studio Pro stopped playback. With Active Noise Cancellation turned on, listening time was up to 24 hours. Battery life depends on device settings, environment, usage, and many other factors.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life of your Beats Studio Pro headphones.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the headphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents.

- **Storage:** When not in use, store the headphones in the provided woven carrying case to protect them from dust, scratches, and impacts.
- **Avoid Moisture:** Keep the headphones away from water and excessive humidity. They are not waterproof.
- **Temperature:** Avoid exposing the headphones to extreme temperatures (hot or cold).
- **Cables:** Handle the charging and audio cables gently. Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Beats Studio Pro headphones, try the following troubleshooting steps:

6.1 No Power / Not Charging

- Ensure the USB-C cable is securely connected to both the headphones and the power source.
- Try a different USB-C cable or power adapter.
- Verify the power source (wall outlet, computer USB port) is functional.

6.2 Cannot Pair / Bluetooth Connection Issues

- Ensure the headphones are in pairing mode (pulsing LED lights).
- Turn off and then on the Bluetooth on your device.
- Move the headphones closer to your device.
- Forget "Beats Studio Pro" from your device's Bluetooth settings and attempt to pair again.
- Restart both your headphones and your device.

6.3 No Sound / Poor Sound Quality

- Check the volume levels on both the headphones and your connected device.
- Ensure the headphones are properly paired and connected.
- If using the 3.5mm audio cable, ensure it is fully inserted into both the headphones and the audio source.
- Try playing audio from a different application or source.
- If using USB-C Lossless Audio, ensure your device and content are compatible.

6.4 ANC / Transparency Mode Not Working

- Ensure the headphones are powered on and have sufficient battery.
- Press the Mode button on the right earcup to cycle through the modes.
- Ensure the earcups are properly sealed around your ears.

6.5 Resetting Your Headphones

If issues persist, you may need to reset your Beats Studio Pro headphones. Refer to the Quick Start Guide or the official Beats support website for specific reset instructions, as procedures can vary.
