1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your new OPPO Reno 8T 4G smartphone. This guide provides essential information to help you get started, operate, maintain, and troubleshoot your device. The OPPO Reno 8T features a 6.43-inch display, 256GB internal storage, 8GB RAM, and a 5000mAh battery. It runs on Android 13.0 and supports dual SIM functionality. Enjoy features like 33W SuperVOOC fast charging, a 100MP AI triple camera, and a MediaTek Helio G99 processor.

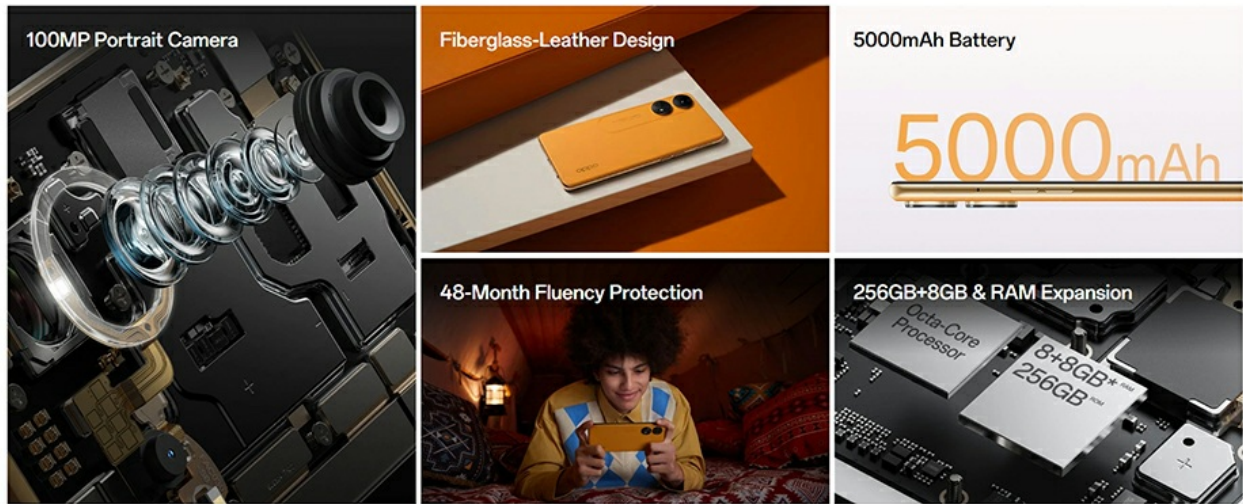


Figure 2.1: Items included in the OPPO Reno 8T retail package.

3. DEVICE OVERVIEW

3.1 Physical Dimensions

The OPPO Reno 8T is designed with a sleek form factor. Dimensions and weight may vary slightly based on material (plastic or leather finish).

- **Height:** Approximately 160.8mm
- **Width:** Approximately 73.84mm
- **Thickness:** Approximately 7.8mm (Plastic) / 7.85mm (Leather)
- **Weight:** Approximately 180g (Plastic) / 183g (Leather)

3.2 Ports and Buttons

Familiarize yourself with the location of key components:

- **Power Button:** Located on the right side.
- **Volume Buttons:** Located on the left side.
- **USB Type-C Port:** Located at the bottom for charging and data transfer.
- **SIM Card Tray:** Located on the side, accessible with the SIM ejector tool.
- **Cameras:** Triple rear camera setup and a single front camera.

4. SETUP

4.1 Inserting SIM Cards

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your phone.
2. Insert the SIM ejector tool into the small hole next to the tray and press gently until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano SIM cards into the designated slots on the tray. Ensure the gold contacts face downwards.
4. Carefully push the tray back into the phone until it clicks into place.

4.2 Initial Power On and Configuration

1. Press and hold the Power button until the OPPO logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, region, and connect to a Wi-Fi network.
3. Sign in with your Google account or create a new one.
4. Set up screen lock (PIN, pattern, password) and biometric security (face recognition).
5. Complete the setup process to access your home screen.

4.3 Charging the Battery

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge the device. Use the provided charger and USB Type-C cable.

1. Connect the USB cable to the charger adapter.
2. Plug the charger into a power outlet.
3. Connect the USB Type-C end of the cable to the phone's charging port.
4. The charging indicator will appear on the screen.

5. OPERATING YOUR SMARTPHONE

5.1 Basic Navigation

- **Touch:** Tap an icon to open an app or select an item.
- **Swipe:** Move your finger across the screen to scroll or navigate between screens.
- **Pinch:** Use two fingers to zoom in or out on photos and web pages.
- **Long Press:** Press and hold an item for more options.

5.2 Making Calls and Sending Messages

- **Calls:** Open the Phone app, enter the number, and tap the call icon.
- **Messages:** Open the Messages app, tap the new message icon, enter the recipient and your message.

5.3 Connecting to the Internet

- **Wi-Fi:** Go to Settings > Wi-Fi, turn it on, and select a network.
- **Mobile Data:** Go to Settings > Mobile network, and enable mobile data.

5.4 Using the Camera

Your OPPO Reno 8T features a 100MP AI triple rear camera and a front camera.

1. Open the Camera app.

2. Select your desired shooting mode (e.g., Photo, Portrait, Panorama).
3. Tap the shutter button to take a photo or start recording a video.
4. Switch between front and rear cameras using the camera switch icon.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Battery Care

- Avoid extreme temperatures, as they can degrade battery life.
- Use only the original or certified chargers and cables.
- For optimal battery health, avoid frequently draining the battery completely or keeping it at 100% for extended periods.

6.2 Cleaning Your Device

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- If the device is water-resistant, ensure all ports are closed before exposure to liquids.

6.3 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your device has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements.

- Go to Settings > About device > Up to date.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to download and install any available updates.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to some common issues:

Issue	Solution
Phone does not turn on	Ensure the battery is charged. Press and hold the Power button for at least 10 seconds to force restart.
Apps are crashing or freezing	Clear the app's cache (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage > Clear cache). Restart the phone.
Poor battery life	Reduce screen brightness, close unused apps, disable unnecessary features like GPS or Bluetooth when not in use. Check battery usage in Settings.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Restart your router and phone. Forget the network and reconnect. Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled.
SIM card not detected	Ensure the SIM card is correctly inserted. Restart the phone. Try the SIM card in another device to check if it's functional.
