# Vivo T3x 5G Smartphone User Manual

Model: Vivo T3x

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Vivo T3x 5G smartphone. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize the device's capabilities.

The Vivo T3x 5G is powered by the Snapdragon 6 Gen 1 4nm 5G mobile platform, featuring an 8-core CPU architecture. This platform is designed for efficient performance, supporting smooth gaming and multitasking experiences.

## 2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon opening your Vivo T3x 5G package, verify that all the following items are included:

- Vivo T3x 5G Smartphone
- Documentation (including this user manual)

- USB Cable
- USB Power Adapter
- SIM Eject Tool
- Protective Film (pre-applied on screen)
- Phone Case

## 3. SETUP

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### 3.1 Inserting the SIM Card

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your device.
2. Insert the SIM eject tool into the small hole next to the tray and press gently until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano-SIM card(s) and/or microSD card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down, ensuring they are correctly oriented.
4. Carefully push the tray back into the phone until it is flush with the device's side.

### 3.2 Initial Power On and Charging

1. Press and hold the Power button (located on the side) until the Vivo logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup, including language selection, Wi-Fi connection, and Google account login.
3. To charge the device, connect the USB cable to the phone's USB-C port and the USB Power Adapter, then plug the adapter into a power outlet.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## 4.1 Power On/Off and Restart

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the device vibrates and the Vivo logo appears.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button for a few seconds, then tap 'Power off' on the screen.
- **Restart:** Press and hold the Power button for a few seconds, then tap 'Restart' on the screen.

## 4.2 Basic Navigation

The Vivo T3x 5G features a responsive touchscreen. Use the following gestures for navigation:

- **Tap:** Select an item or open an app.
- **Swipe:** Scroll through lists or switch between home screens.
- **Pinch:** Zoom in or out on images and web pages.
- **Long Press:** Access contextual menus or move app icons.

## 4.3 Camera Usage

Your device is equipped with a 50MP + 2MP rear camera and an 8MP front camera. Open the Camera app to capture photos and videos. Tap the shutter button to take a picture, or switch to video mode to record.

## 4.4 Connectivity

- **Wi-Fi:** Go to Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi to connect to available networks.
- **Bluetooth:** Go to Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth to pair with other Bluetooth devices.
- **Mobile Data (5G):** Ensure your SIM card has an active data plan. Enable mobile data in Quick Settings or Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network.

## 4.5 Display Features

The Vivo T3x 5G features a 17.07 cm (6.72 inch) Full HD+ display with a 120Hz refresh rate for smooth visuals.

## 4.6 Battery Management

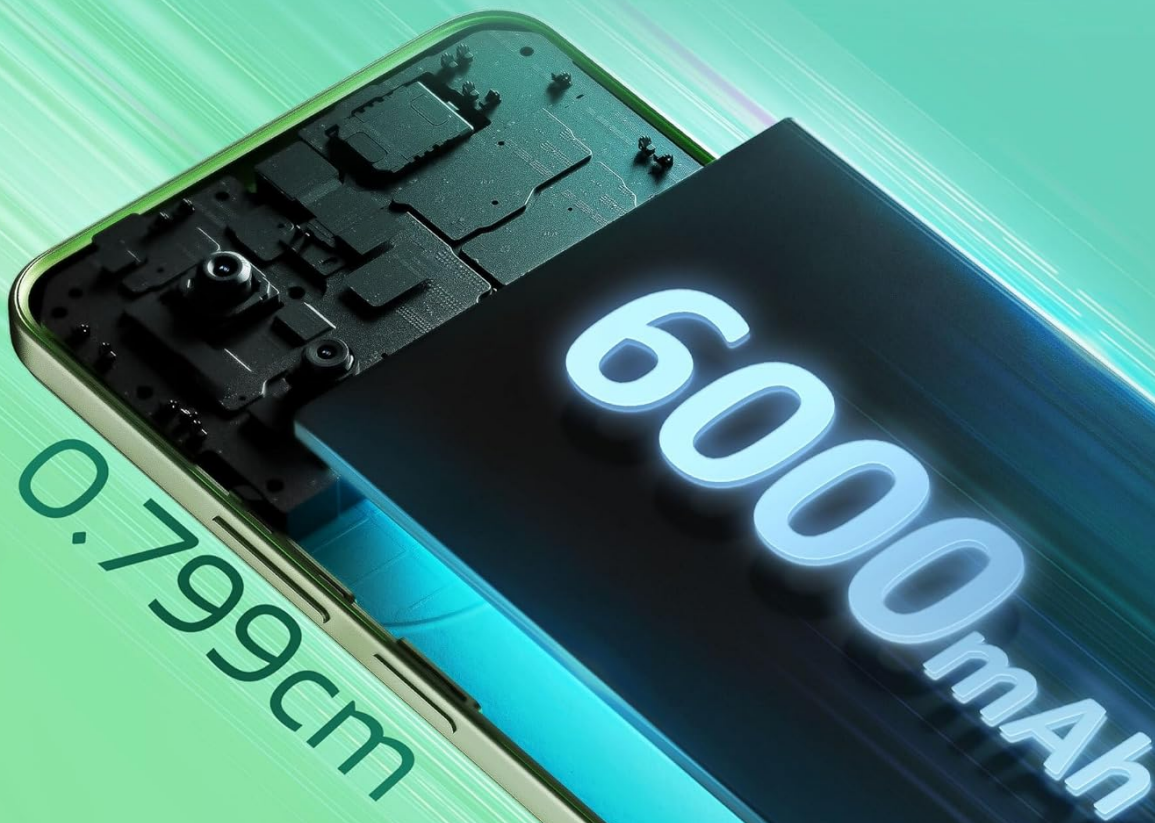
The device is equipped with a 6000 mAh battery and supports 44W FlashCharge. To optimize battery life:

- Adjust screen brightness.
- Disable Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, and GPS when not in use.
- Close background applications.
- Utilize Battery Saver Mode (Settings > Battery).

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Cleaning Your Device

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of your phone. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the device's finish.

### 5.2 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to Settings > System > System update.

### 5.3 Battery Care

To prolong battery lifespan, avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures. Do not fully discharge the battery frequently, and avoid leaving it plugged in for extended periods after it's fully charged.

## 5.4 Storage Management

Periodically clear unnecessary files, cache data, and uninstall unused applications to free up storage space and maintain device speed. Your device has 128 GB of internal storage, expandable up to 1 TB with a microSD card.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Vivo T3x 5G.

- **Device Not Powering On:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the phone to its charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power it on again. If it still doesn't turn on, perform a forced restart by holding the Power button for about 10-15 seconds.
- **Screen Unresponsive:** If the screen is frozen, try restarting the device. If the issue persists, ensure your hands are clean and dry, and that there are no screen protectors interfering with touch sensitivity.
- **Connectivity Problems (Wi-Fi/Bluetooth/5G):**
  - Toggle Wi-Fi/Bluetooth/Mobile Data off and on.
  - Restart your phone.
  - For Wi-Fi, restart your router.
  - For mobile data, ensure your SIM card is active and has a data plan.
- **Battery Draining Quickly:** Review section 4.6 on Battery Management. Reduce screen brightness, disable unused features, and close background apps. Check for apps consuming excessive power in Settings > Battery.
- **Device Lagging/Slow Performance:** Clear cache, uninstall unused apps, and ensure sufficient storage space. Restarting the device can also help.
- **Factory Reset (Last Resort):** If issues persist, you may need to perform a factory reset. This will erase all data on your phone. **Backup all important data before proceeding.** Go to Settings > System > Reset options > Erase all data (factory reset).

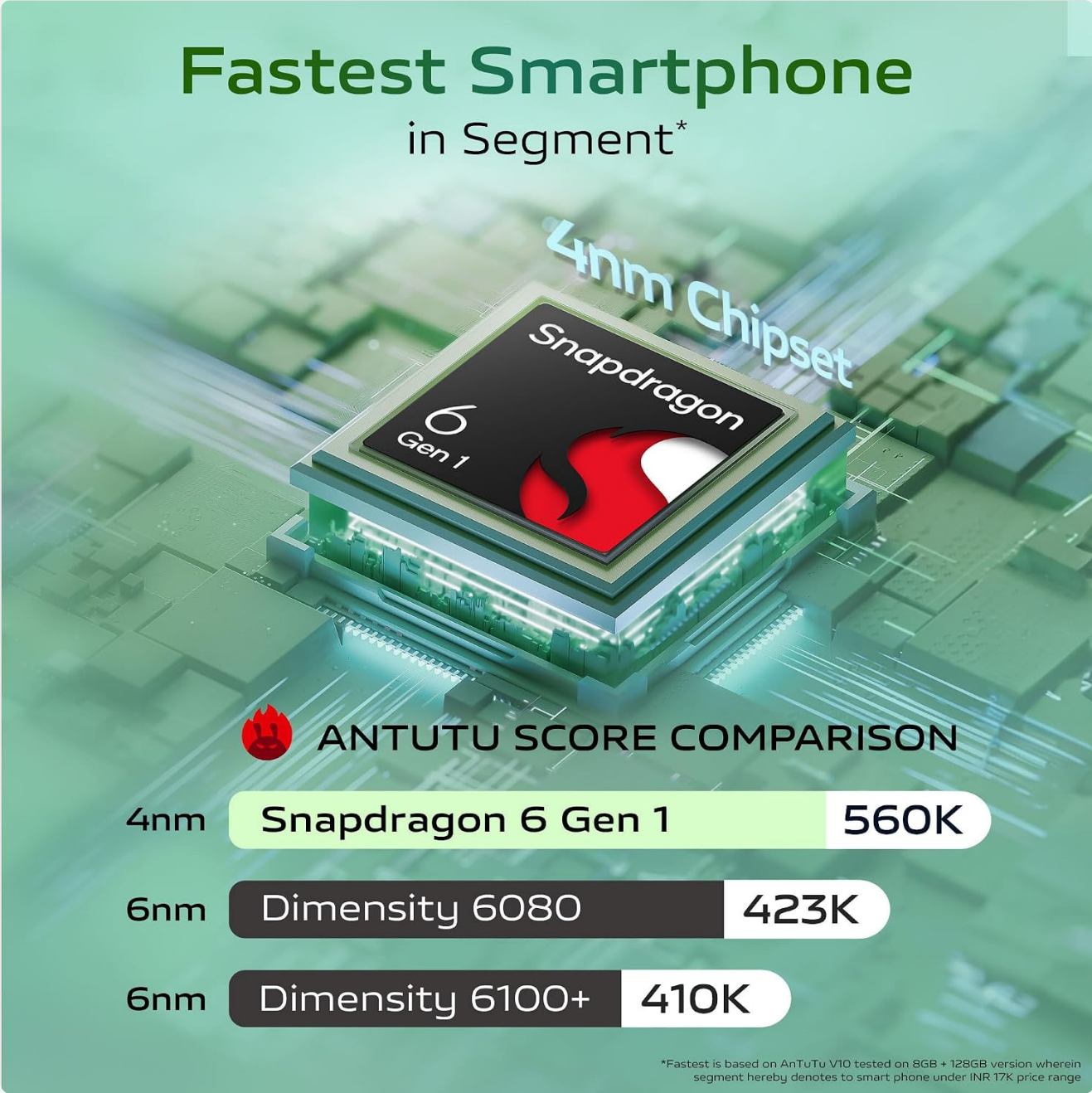


Image 7.1: Snapdragon 6 Gen 1 chipset performance overview.
