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1. INTRODUCTION

The full-size keyboard features quiet, low-profile keys and dedicated multimedia controls, while the compact mouse ensures comfortable and precise navigation. 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2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1. Battery Installation

The keyboard requires two AAA batteries, and the mouse requires one AA battery. Batteries are typically included with the product. If not already installed, open the battery compartments on the underside of both the keyboard and mouse, insert the batteries according to the polarity indicators (+/-), and close the compartments. Remove any plastic pull tabs if present.

3.2. Connecting the Receiver

The Logitech MK275 uses a single USB Nano Receiver for both the keyboard and mouse. This allows you to use only one USB port on your computer.

1. Locate the USB Nano Receiver. It is small and designed to be left in your computer.
2. Plug the USB Nano Receiver into an available USB port on your desktop PC or laptop.
3. Turn on the keyboard and mouse using their respective On/Off switches, usually located on the underside of each device.
4. Your computer should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. No software installation is typically required for Windows XP, Vista, Windows 7, and Windows 8.

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4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Basic Usage

Once the USB Nano Receiver is connected and the devices are powered on, your keyboard and mouse are ready for immediate use. The 2.4 GHz wireless connection provides a strong and reliable signal, minimizing lag and interference.

4.2. Multimedia and Shortcut Keys

The Logitech MK275 keyboard features 8 convenient multimedia and shortcut keys located above the function keys (F1-F12). These keys provide quick access to frequently used functions:

- **Home:** Opens your default web browser's home page.

- **Volume Down:** Decreases audio volume.
- **Volume Up:** Increases audio volume.
- **Play/Pause:** Controls media playback.
- **Calculator:** Opens the calculator application.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Logitech MK275 set, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to clean the surfaces of the keyboard and mouse. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Spill Resistance:** The keyboard is designed to be spill-resistant. In case of accidental spills, immediately turn off the keyboard, disconnect it, and allow it to dry completely before reuse. Do not immerse the keyboard in liquid.
- **Battery Life:** The keyboard offers up to 24 months of battery life, and the mouse up to 12 months. Battery life may vary based on usage. Replace batteries when performance degrades.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, turn off both the keyboard and mouse to conserve battery life. Store the USB Nano Receiver in the dedicated slot within the mouse (if available) or in a safe place to prevent loss.
- **Environment:** Avoid exposing the devices to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, or high humidity.

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6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Logitech MK275 set, try the following solutions:

- **No Connection/Lag:**
 - Ensure the USB Nano Receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port.
 - Verify that both the keyboard and mouse are turned on.
 - Replace the batteries in both devices. Low battery can cause connection issues.
 - Move the keyboard and mouse closer to the receiver. The effective range is approximately 10 meters (33 feet).
 - Try plugging the receiver into a different USB port or a different computer to rule out port issues.
 - Avoid placing the receiver near other electrical devices that might cause interference (e.g., cordless phones, Wi-Fi routers).
 - **Keys Not Responding:**
 - Check battery levels.
 - Ensure the keyboard is turned on.
 - If specific keys are not working, check for debris under the keycaps.
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- **Mouse Cursor Jumps or is Erratic:**
 - Clean the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse.
 - Use the mouse on a clean, non-reflective surface.
 - Check battery levels.
