3. SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to set up your Logitech G PRO X SUPERLIGHT 2 Wireless Gaming Mouse:

1. **Charge the Mouse:** Connect the USB A to C charging/data cable to the mouse and a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port or wall adapter). The mouse features a 95-hour battery life on a full charge.
2. **Connect the LIGHTSPEED Adapter:**
 - For optimal performance, use the USB LIGHTSPEED adapter with the adapter extension cable. Plug the extension cable into a USB port on your computer, then connect the LIGHTSPEED adapter to the extension cable. This brings the receiver closer to the mouse, reducing interference.
 - Alternatively, you can plug the LIGHTSPEED adapter directly into a USB port on your computer.

3. **Power On the Mouse:** Locate the power switch on the underside of the mouse and slide it to the ON position. The LED indicator on the mouse will illuminate.
4. **Install G HUB Software (Recommended):** For full customization of DPI settings (up to 44,000 DPI), programmable buttons, and other advanced features, download and install the Logitech G HUB software from the official Logitech G website. This software allows you to fine-tune your mouse performance.
5. **Apply Optional Grip Tape:** If desired, apply the included grip tape to the mouse for enhanced grip and comfort.
6. **Replace Aperture Door (Optional):** The mouse comes with an optional aperture door with a PTFE foot. You can replace the default door for a different glide experience.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Logitech G PRO X SUPERLIGHT 2 is designed for intuitive use with advanced features for competitive gaming.

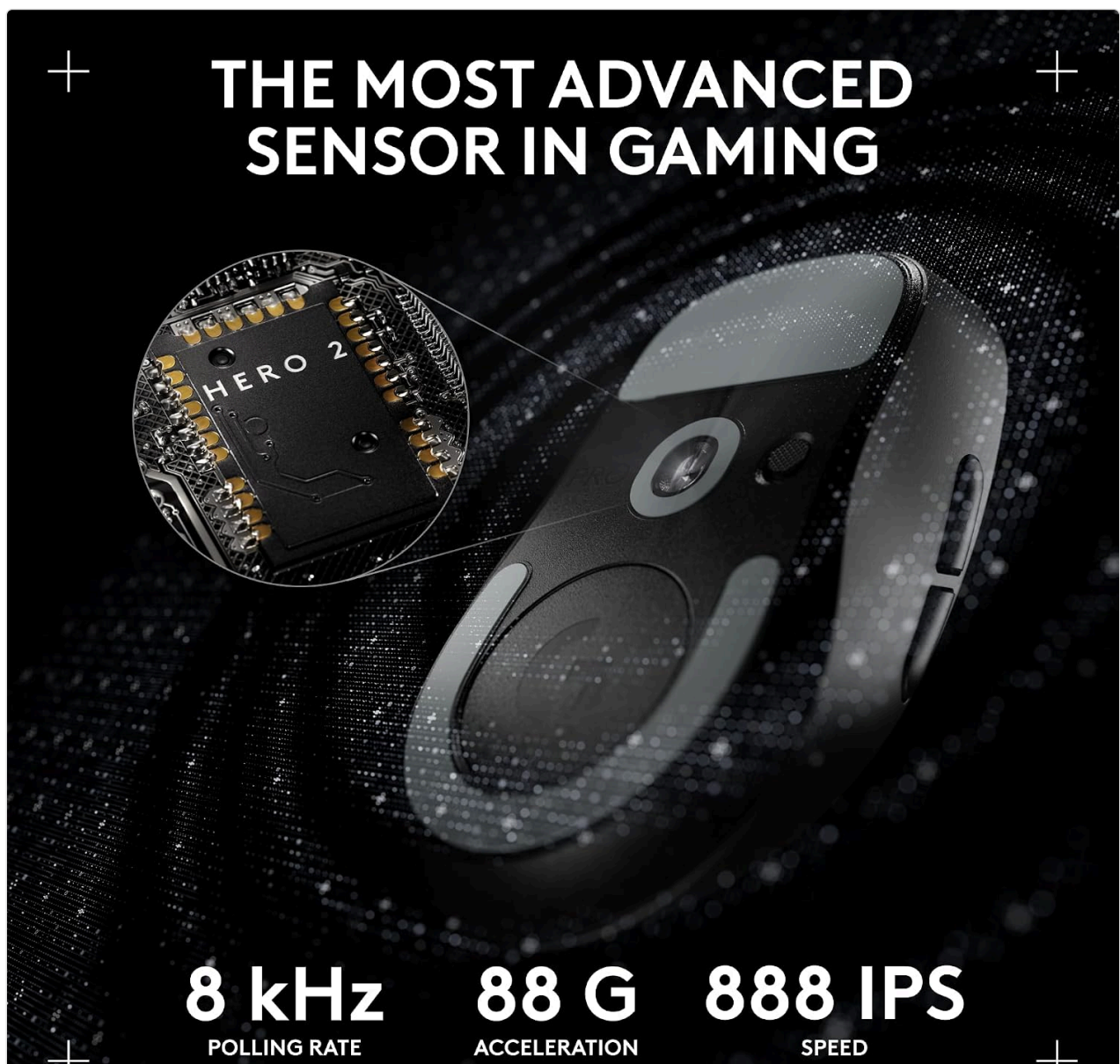
4.1 Basic Operation

- **Movement:** Glide the mouse across your mousepad. The HERO 2 sensor provides precise tracking with up to 888+ IPS speed and 88 G-force acceleration.

- **Scroll Wheel:** Use the scroll wheel for vertical navigation in documents and web pages. The scroll wheel also functions as a middle click button.
- **Side Buttons:** The mouse includes customizable side buttons, typically used for forward and backward navigation in web browsers or for in-game commands. These can be reconfigured via G HUB.

4.2 Advanced Features (via G HUB Software)

- **DPI Adjustment:** Customize DPI sensitivity from 100 to 44,000 DPI to match your preference and game requirements. You can set multiple DPI levels and switch between them on the fly.
- **Button Assignment:** Reassign functions to any of the 5 programmable buttons, including macros, system commands, or specific game actions.
- **Polling Rate:** The mouse supports an 8 kHz report rate, delivering 8 times the data flow of standard mice for ultra-responsive performance. This can be configured in G HUB.
- **Battery Management:** Monitor battery level and optimize power settings for extended use. The mouse offers up to 95 hours of continuous gaming.



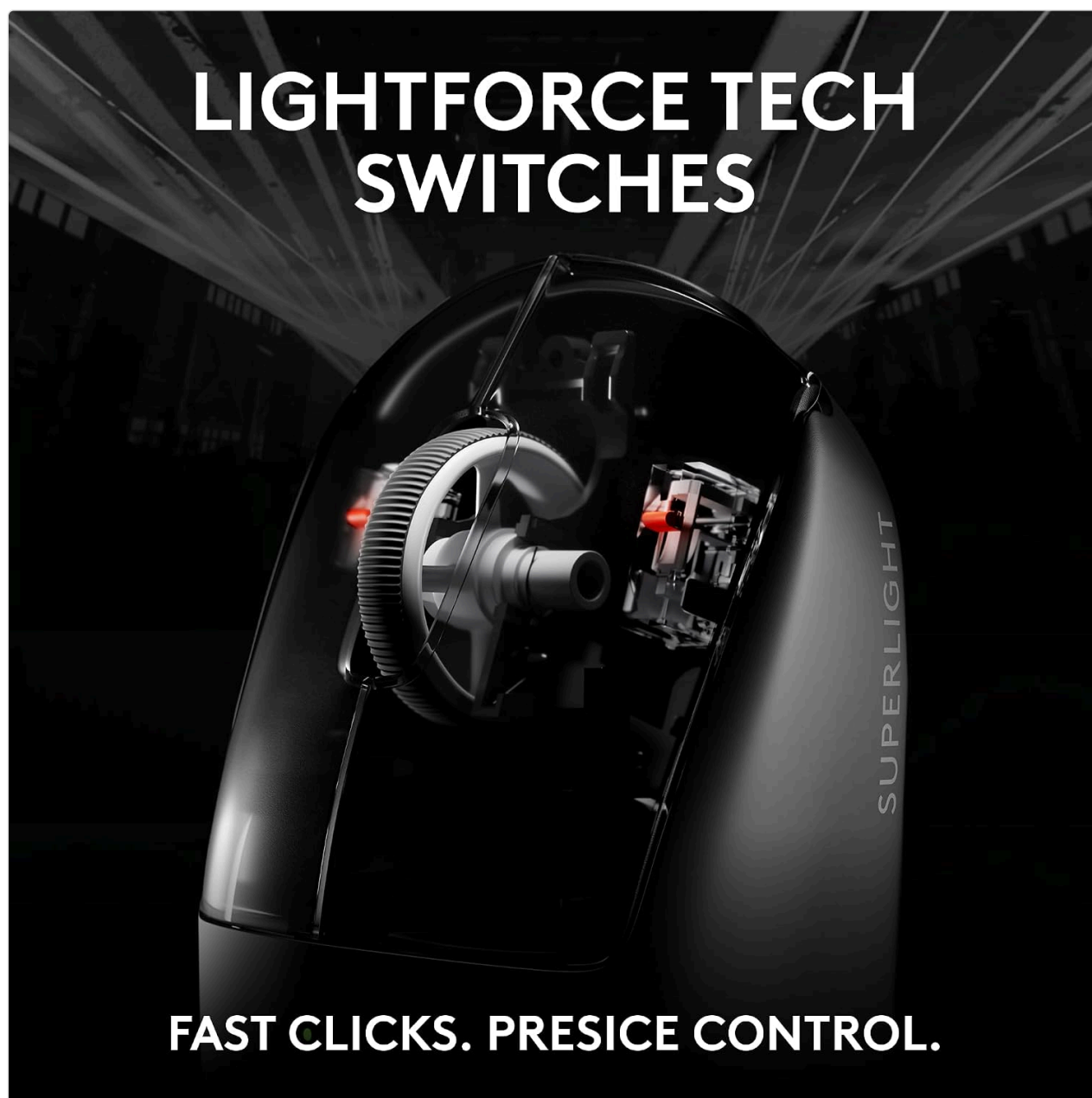


Figure 5: Internal view of LIGHTFORCE hybrid switches for fast and precise clicks.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Logitech G PRO X SUPERLIGHT 2 Wireless Gaming Mouse.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe the surface of the mouse. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive materials.
- **Sensor Cleaning:** Occasionally inspect the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse for dust or debris. Use a

- **PTFE Feet:** The Zero-Additive PTFE mouse feet are designed for smooth gliding. If they become worn or damaged, replacement feet can be obtained from authorized Logitech G retailers.
- **Battery Care:** To maximize battery life, avoid fully discharging the mouse frequently. Charge the mouse when the battery indicator is low. Store the mouse in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Logitech G PRO X SUPERLIGHT 2, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mouse not responding/connecting	Low battery; LIGHTSPEED adapter not connected or out of range; driver issue.	Charge the mouse. Ensure the LIGHTSPEED adapter is securely plugged into a USB port, preferably using the extension cable to bring it closer to the mouse. Try a different USB port. Reinstall Logitech G HUB software or update drivers.
Lagging or erratic cursor movement	Interference; dirty sensor; poor surface; low battery.	Ensure no other wireless devices are causing interference. Clean the optical sensor. Use a clean, uniform mousepad. Charge the mouse.
Buttons not responding	Software conflict; physical obstruction.	Check button assignments in Logitech G HUB. Ensure no physical debris is preventing button presses. Restart your computer.
Mouse not charging	Faulty cable or USB port; mouse not properly connected.	Try a different USB-C cable and/or USB port. Ensure the cable is fully inserted into the mouse.

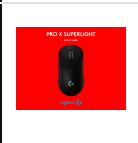
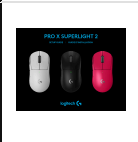
