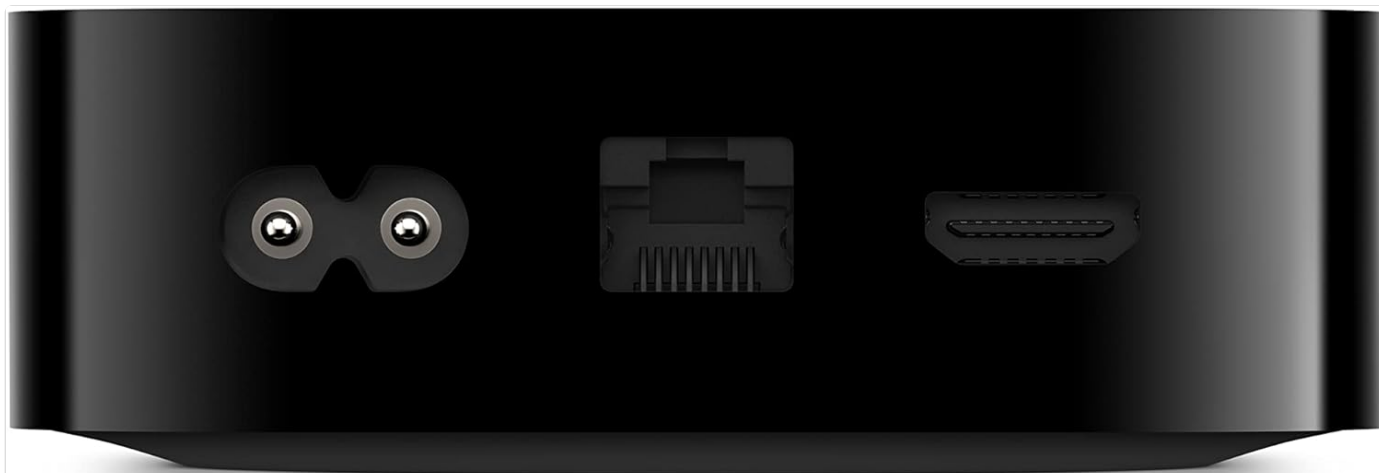




Siri Remote Features

Apple TV 4K Ports

The rear of the Apple TV 4K unit features essential connectivity ports:

- **Power Port:** Connect the included power cord.
- **Gigabit Ethernet Port:** For wired internet connection (optional, Wi-Fi is also available).
- **HDMI 2.1 Port:** Connect to your TV or receiver using an HDMI cable (not included).

SETUP GUIDE

1. Connect Apple TV 4K to your TV

1. Connect one end of an HDMI 2.1 cable (sold separately) to the HDMI port on the back of your Apple TV 4K.
2. Connect the other end of the HDMI cable to an HDMI input on your television or AV receiver.
3. Connect the power cord to the power port on the back of your Apple TV 4K, then plug the other end into a power outlet.
4. *Optional:* For a wired internet connection, connect an Ethernet cable from your router to the Gigabit Ethernet port on the back of your Apple TV 4K.

2. Power On and Initial Configuration

1. Turn on your TV and select the HDMI input that your Apple TV 4K is connected to.
2. The Siri Remote should automatically pair with your Apple TV 4K. If not, press any button on the remote. If it still doesn't pair, hold the **Volume Down** and **TV/Control Center** buttons for 5 seconds.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language, region, and connect to a Wi-Fi network (if not using Ethernet).
4. You can choose to set up your Apple TV 4K using an iPhone or iPad for faster configuration, or manually.
5. Sign in with your Apple ID to access purchased content and services.

Navigating with the Siri Remote

- **Clickpad:** Swipe up, down, left, or right to navigate menus. Press the center of the clickpad to select an item.
- **Siri Button:** Press and hold to activate Siri for voice commands. Release to end the command.
- **TV/Control Center Button:** Press once to go to the Apple TV app. Press and hold to open Control Center.
- **Back Button:** Press to go back to the previous screen or menu.
- **Play/Pause Button:** Press to play or pause content.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust the volume of your TV or connected audio system.
- **Power Button:** Press to turn Apple TV and your TV on or off.

Using Apps and Services

The Apple TV 4K provides access to a wide range of streaming services and apps, including Netflix, HBO Max, Amazon Prime Video, Disney+, Apple TV+, Apple Music, Apple Arcade, and Apple Fitness+. You can download additional apps from the App Store.

AirPlay

Use AirPlay to wirelessly share photos, videos, presentations, and more from your iPhone, iPad, or Mac directly to your TV through Apple TV 4K. Ensure both devices are on the same Wi-Fi network.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the Apple TV 4K unit and Siri Remote. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or sprays.
- **Software Updates:** Apple TV 4K regularly receives software updates to improve performance and add new features. Ensure your device is connected to the internet to receive these updates automatically or check manually in Settings > System > Software Updates.
- **Storage Management:** While the 128GB storage is ample, you can manage app storage in Settings > General > Manage Storage if needed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
No picture on TV	Ensure HDMI cable is securely connected to both Apple TV and TV. Verify TV is set to the correct HDMI input. Check if Apple TV is powered on (indicator light is on). Try a different HDMI cable or HDMI port on your TV.

Problem	Solution
Siri Remote not responding	Ensure the remote is charged (connect via USB-C). Point the remote at the Apple TV. Restart Apple TV by unplugging it from power for 6 seconds, then plugging it back in. Re-pair the remote: Hold Volume Down and TV/Control Center buttons for 5 seconds.
No sound	Check TV or receiver volume. Verify audio output settings on Apple TV (Settings > Video and Audio > Audio Output). Ensure HDMI cable is functioning correctly.
Network connection issues	Check Wi-Fi password if connecting wirelessly. Restart your router and modem. If using Ethernet, ensure the cable is connected properly. Go to Settings > Network to check connection status.
