1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your AKAI 50-inch 4K Ultra HD Smart LED Fire TV, model AKLT50U-F7VSW. Please read these instructions thoroughly before operating the television and retain them for future reference. This television features a 4K Ultra HD display, integrated Fire TV OS, and built-in Alexa voice control.

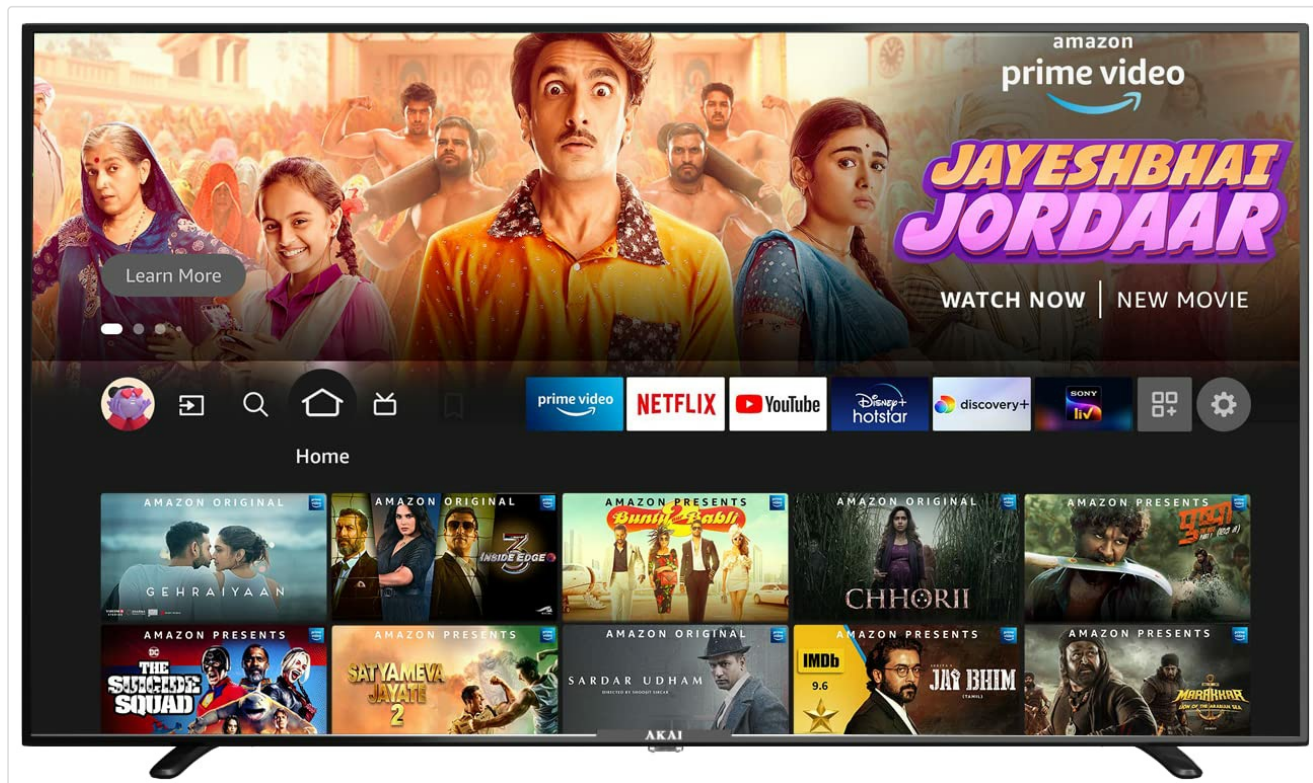


Image 1.1: Front view of the AKAI 50-inch 4K Ultra HD Smart LED Fire TV.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Verify that all components are present upon unboxing:

- 1 LED TV
- 2 Table Stand Base
- 1 Wall Mount (bracket and screws)
- 1 User Manual (this document)
- 1 Warranty Card
- 1 Remote Control
- 2 AAA batteries (for remote control)

3. SETUP

3.1 Physical Installation

Your television can be installed using either the included table stand bases or a wall mount.

Table Stand Installation:

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, flat surface to prevent damage.
2. Attach the two table stand bases to the designated slots on the bottom of the TV using the provided screws. Ensure they are securely fastened.
3. Place the TV on a stable, level surface.

Wall Mount Installation:

The TV supports a VESA mount standard of 400 x 400 mm. Professional installation is recommended for wall mounting to ensure safety and proper alignment.

1. Refer to the wall mount kit instructions for specific installation steps.
2. Ensure the wall can support the weight of the television.
3. Attach the wall mount brackets to the rear of the TV using appropriate screws.
4. Mount the TV securely to the wall bracket.

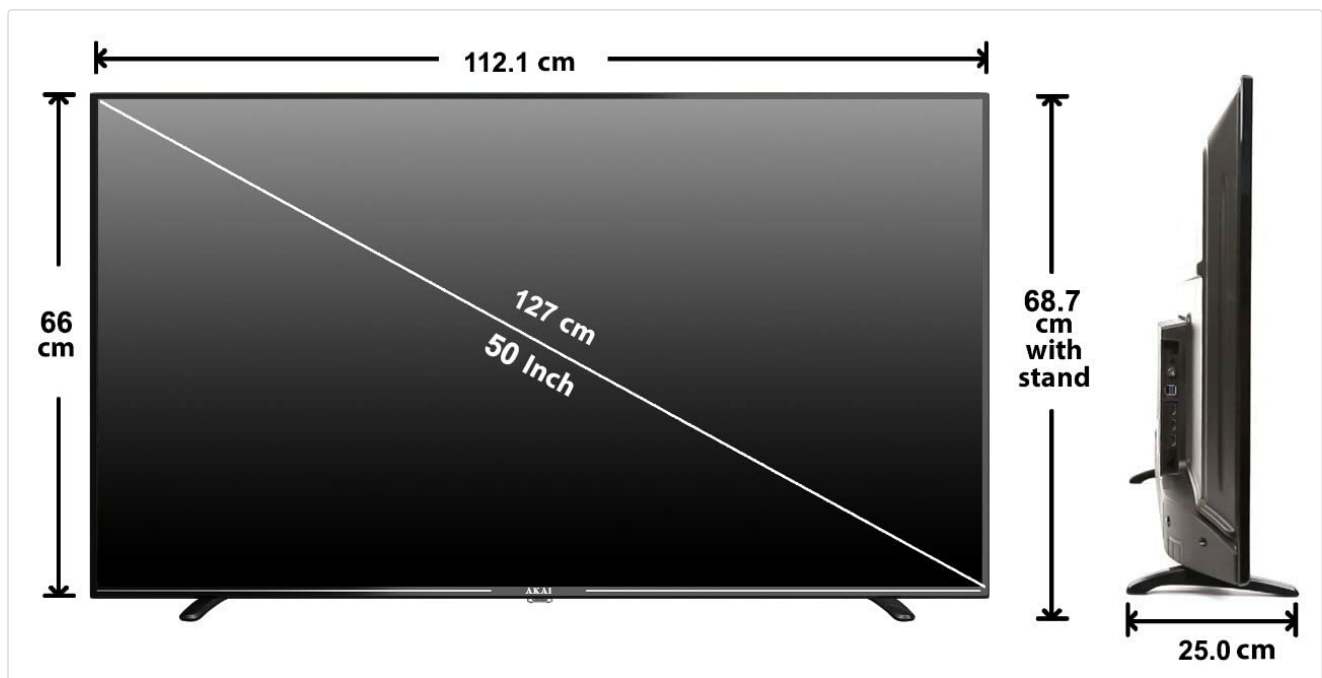


Image 3.1: Television dimensions for installation planning.

3.2 Connections

Connect external devices to your television using the available ports.

- **HDMI Ports (3):** Connect set-top boxes, Blu-ray players, gaming consoles, or other HDMI-compatible devices.
- **USB Ports (3):** Connect hard drives, USB flash drives, or other USB devices for media playback.
- **Ethernet Port:** For a wired internet connection.
- **Wi-Fi:** For wireless internet connectivity.
- **IR Port:** To control connected devices like DVD/STB players.

3.3 Initial Power On and Fire TV OS Setup

1. Connect the power cord to the TV and a power outlet.
2. Press the power button on the remote control or the TV.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including language selection, network connection (Wi-Fi or Ethernet), and Amazon account login for Fire TV OS.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Remote Control with Alexa Voice Control

The included remote control features built-in Alexa for voice commands. Insert the two AAA batteries into the remote control before use.

- Press the microphone button on the remote and speak your command to Alexa (e.g., "Alexa, open Netflix," "Alexa, play movies").
- Use the navigation buttons to browse menus and select options.
- Dedicated buttons provide quick access to popular streaming services.

- **DTH Set-Top Box Integration:** Seamlessly switch between DTH TV channels and OTT apps from the home screen.

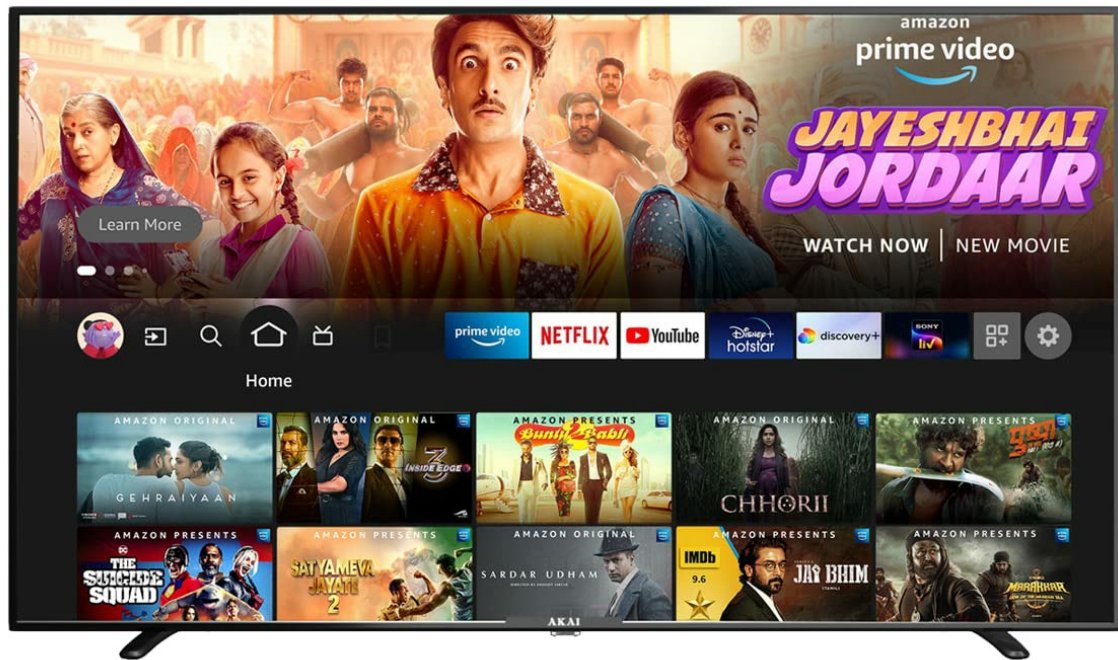


Image 4.2: The Fire TV OS home screen displaying available streaming applications.

- **Sound Quality:** Enjoy powerful 20 Watts audio output with Dolby Atmos for immersive sound.

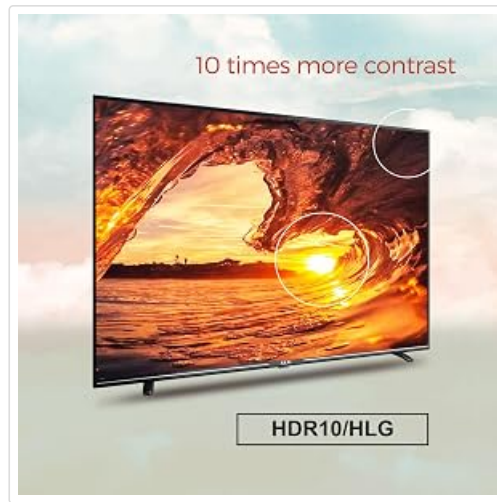


Image 4.3: Visual representation of the 4K UHD display quality.

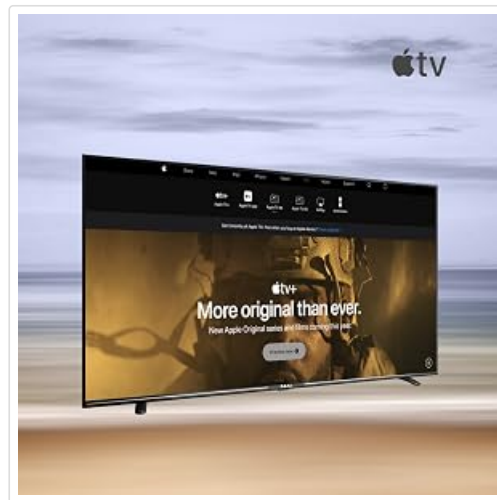


Image 4.4: Illustration of Dolby Vision Atmos audio experience.

- **Data Monitoring:** Monitor your internet data usage directly from the TV.

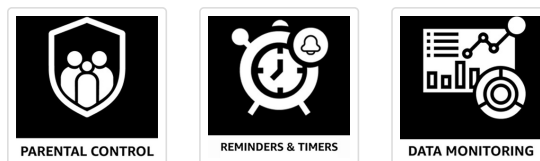


Image 4.5: Icons representing Parental Control, Reminders & Timers, and Data Monitoring features.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your television.

5.1 Cleaning

- **Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, use a screen-specific cleaning solution applied to the cloth, not directly to the screen.

- **Cabinet:** Wipe the TV cabinet with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.
- Always unplug the TV before cleaning.

5.2 Safety Precautions

- Do not block ventilation openings on the TV.
- Avoid exposing the TV to direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, or high humidity.
- Keep the TV away from sources of strong magnetic fields.
- Do not attempt to repair the TV yourself. Refer to qualified service personnel.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to this section for solutions to common issues. If the problem persists, contact customer support.

Problem	Possible Solution
No Power	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and a working electrical outlet. Check the power indicator light on the TV.
No Picture, but Sound is Present	Check the input source. Ensure the connected device is powered on and functioning correctly. Try a different HDMI cable.
No Sound, but Picture is Present	Check the volume level and ensure the TV is not muted. Verify audio settings in the TV menu. If using external audio, check its connections and power.
Remote Control Not Responding	Replace the AAA batteries in the remote control. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor. Re-pair the remote if it's a Bluetooth remote.
Network Connection Issues	Restart your Wi-Fi router. Check Wi-Fi settings on the TV and ensure the correct password is entered. Try connecting via an Ethernet cable if available.
Picture Quality Issues (e.g., blurry, distorted)	Check the resolution settings of the input source. Ensure the TV's picture mode is set appropriately (e.g., Standard, Movie, Game).
