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1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your new Haier HED-223RFB-P 215L Direct Cool Single Door Refrigerator. Please read these instructions thoroughly before using the appliance and retain them for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Important Safety Instructions:



- Ensure the refrigerator is connected to a grounded power outlet.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction.
- Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments, unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or performing maintenance.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Your Haier HED-223RFB-P refrigerator is designed for efficient cooling and convenient storage. Key features include:

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- **Direct Cool Technology:** Provides powerful and long-lasting cooling.
- **1 Hour Icing Technology:** Rapid ice formation.
- **Stabilizer Free Operation:** Operates safely within 110V-300V.
- **Anti-Bacterial Gasket:** Helps keep food hygienic and prevents bacterial build-up.

- **Base Stand with Drawer:** Provides additional storage space for non-refrigerated items.
- **Toughened Glass Shelves:** Durable and easy to clean.
- **Large Vegetable Crisper:** Designed to keep vegetables fresh.
- **Utility Box:** Convenient storage for smaller items.
- **Big Bottle Guard:** Accommodates large bottles.
- **Auto Connect to Home Inverter:** Ensures uninterrupted cooling during power outages.

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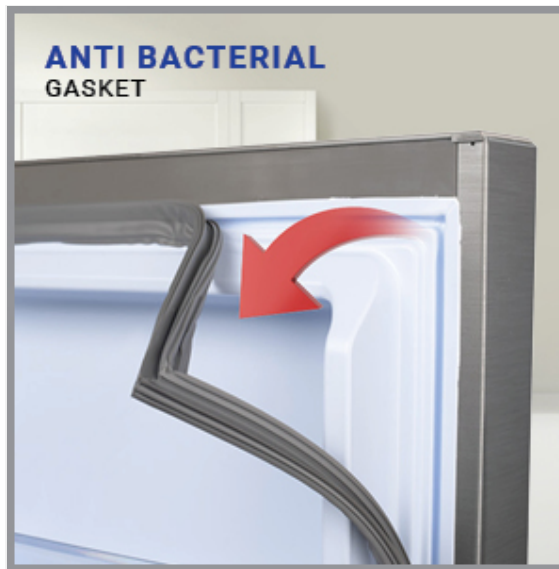


Image: Detailed view of the 1 Hour Icing Technology, showing rapid ice formation.



Image: Illustration demonstrating the Anti-Bacterial Gasket for improved hygiene.

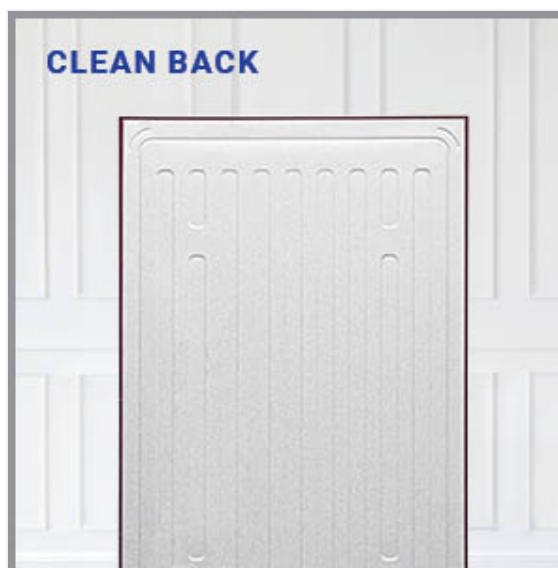


Image: Diagram illustrating the refrigerator's Stabilizer Free Operation capability within a wide voltage range.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Unpacking:

1. Carefully remove all packaging materials, including tape and protective films.
2. Check for any damage during transit. If damage is found, contact your retailer immediately.
3. Ensure all included accessories (Egg Tray, Ice Tray, User Manual, Warranty Card, Keys) are present.

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Placement:

- Place the refrigerator on a firm, level surface away from direct sunlight, heat sources (e.g., oven, radiator), and moisture.
- Allow adequate space around the appliance for proper ventilation (at least 10 cm at the back and sides, 30 cm at the top).
- Ensure the door can open fully.

Leveling:

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- Adjust the leveling feet at the bottom front of the refrigerator to ensure it is stable and level. This helps prevent vibrations and ensures proper door sealing.

Power Connection:

- Plug the refrigerator into a dedicated, grounded 220V AC power outlet. Do not use extension cords or multi-plugs.
- Allow the refrigerator to stand for at least 2-4 hours before plugging it in to allow refrigerants to settle.

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Initial Cleaning:

- Before first use, clean the interior and exterior of the refrigerator with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Wipe dry thoroughly.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Temperature Control:

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- The temperature control dial is typically located inside the fresh food compartment.
- Turn the dial to adjust the cooling intensity. Higher numbers usually indicate colder temperatures.
- Start with a medium setting and adjust as needed based on ambient temperature and food load.

Manual Defrosting:

- As a Direct Cool refrigerator, frost will accumulate in the freezer compartment. Defrost when the frost layer reaches about 5mm thickness.
- To defrost, unplug the refrigerator. Remove all food items and place them in a cooler.
- Leave the freezer door open to allow frost to melt naturally. Place towels at the bottom to absorb water.
- Do not use sharp objects or heating devices to remove frost.
- Once defrosted, clean and dry the interior before plugging it back in and returning food.

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Using the 1 Hour Icing Technology:

- Place water in the ice tray and position it in the designated area of the freezer.
- Activate the 1 Hour Icing feature (if available via a specific button or setting, refer to the internal label). This feature accelerates ice formation.

Base Stand Drawer:

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- Utilize the base stand drawer for storing non-refrigerated food items like onions, potatoes, or other dry goods.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Cleaning the Interior:

- Regularly clean the interior with a solution of mild detergent and warm water.
- Wipe down shelves, drawers, and walls. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly.
- The Anti-Bacterial Gasket should be cleaned with a damp cloth to maintain its effectiveness.

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Cleaning the Exterior:

- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn stains, use a mild, non-abrasive cleaner.
- Ensure the Easy Clean Back is free from dust and debris to maintain cooling efficiency.

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Power Saving Tips:

- Avoid opening the door frequently or for extended periods.
- Allow hot food to cool down before placing it in the refrigerator.

- Ensure the door gasket is clean and seals properly.
- Defrost the freezer regularly to prevent excessive ice build-up.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting service, check the following common issues:

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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Refrigerator not cooling	Power cord unplugged; Power outage; Temperature setting too high; Door not closed properly; Excessive food load.	Check power connection; Verify power supply; Adjust temperature dial; Ensure door is sealed; Reduce food load if overloaded.
Excessive noise	Refrigerator not level; Objects touching the back or sides; Compressor noise (normal).	Adjust leveling feet; Move objects away from the unit; Compressor noise is normal during operation.
Water leakage inside/outside	Drain hole blocked; Door gasket not sealing; Excessive humidity.	Clear drain hole; Clean and inspect door gasket; Reduce humidity in the room.
Door not closing properly	Food packages obstructing; Door gasket dirty/damaged; Refrigerator not level.	Rearrange items; Clean or replace gasket; Level the refrigerator.
