1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Whirlpool 8.5 kg Semi-Automatic Top Load Washing Machine HydroWash Premier S. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read these instructions carefully before using the washing machine and retain them for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To prevent personal injury or property damage, always follow basic safety precautions, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not wash articles that have been previously cleaned in, washed in, soaked in, or spotted with gasoline, dry-cleaning solvents, or other flammable or explosive substances, as they emit vapors that could ignite or explode.
- Do not allow children to play on or in the appliance. Close supervision of children is necessary when the appliance is used near children.
- Do not reach into the appliance if the tub or agitator is moving.
- Do not install or store this appliance where it will be exposed to the weather.
- Do not tamper with controls.
- Do not repair or replace any part of the appliance or attempt any servicing unless specifically recommended in the user-maintenance instructions or in published user-repair instructions that you understand and have the skills to carry out.
- Always disconnect the appliance from the power supply before attempting any service.
- Ensure the power cord is not damaged. If damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons to avoid a hazard.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning

use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Whirlpool HydroWash Premier S is a semi-automatic top-load washing machine designed for efficient and thorough cleaning. Key features include:

- **3D Wave Technology:** Generates powerful detergent water waves, moving clothes in a three-dimensional motion for a thorough clean.
- **3D Lint Filter:** An advanced three-layer filtration system effectively collects lint, ensuring clothes are fresh and clean.
- **Durable Edge-to-Edge Lids:** Robust hinged lids designed for durability and long-lasting performance.
- **Soft Closing Lid:** The wash tub lid features a soft-closing mechanism, designed to close gently and prevent accidental injury.
- **Hydromax Motor:** A powerful motor capable of washing large loads, such as up to 10 king-size bed sheets in a single cycle.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the safe and efficient operation of your washing machine.

4.1 Unpacking

- Remove all packaging materials, including the base packing.
- Check for any damage during transit. If damaged, do not install and contact customer service.

4.2 Placement

- Place the washing machine on a firm, level surface to minimize vibration and noise during operation.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the machine. Do not block ventilation openings.
- Avoid direct sunlight or extreme temperatures.

4.3 Water Connection

- Connect the water inlet hose to a cold water tap. Ensure the connection is secure to prevent leaks.
- The water pressure should be within the recommended range for optimal performance.

4.4 Drainage

- Position the drain pipe to ensure proper water discharge. It should be placed in a sink or a dedicated drain.
- Ensure the drain hose is not kinked or blocked.

4.5 Power Connection

- Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet (230 Volts).
- Do not use extension cords or adapters.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for effective washing and spinning:

5.1 Control Panel Overview

- **Fabric Type:** Selects the wash intensity based on fabric (e.g., Normal, Delicate, Heavy).
- **Dirt Level:** Adjusts wash time based on how soiled the clothes are (e.g., Off, 5 min, 10 min, 15 min).

- **Drain Selector:** Controls water drainage (Wash, Drain).
- **Max Dryer:** Sets the spin duration for drying (Off, 5 min, 7 min).

5.2 Washing Cycle

1. **Load Clothes:** Open the wash tub lid and place clothes loosely into the wash tub. Do not overload.
2. **Add Detergent:** Add the recommended amount of detergent directly into the wash tub.
3. **Fill Water:** Fill the wash tub with water to the appropriate level for your load size.
4. **Select Program:** Turn the 'Fabric Type' knob to your desired setting (e.g., Normal for everyday clothes).
5. **Set Wash Time:** Turn the 'Dirt Level' knob to select the wash duration (e.g., 10 min for moderately soiled clothes).
6. **Start Washing:** The machine will begin the wash cycle.
7. **Drain Water:** Once the wash cycle is complete, turn the 'Drain Selector' knob to 'Drain' to empty the water.

5.3 Spin Cycle

1. **Transfer Clothes:** Carefully transfer the washed clothes from the wash tub to the spin tub. Distribute them evenly.
2. **Secure Spin Cover:** Place the spin cover unit securely over the clothes in the spin tub.
3. **Set Spin Time:** Turn the 'Max Dryer' knob to select the desired spin duration (e.g., 5 min for standard drying).
4. **Start Spinning:** Close the spin tub lid. The machine will begin the spin cycle.
5. **Remove Clothes:** Once the spin cycle is complete, open the lid and carefully remove the spun clothes.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your washing machine.

6.1 Cleaning the Lint Filter

- The 3D Lint Filter is located inside the wash tub.

- After every few washes, remove the lint filter and clean out any accumulated lint and debris.
- Rinse the filter under running water and reinsert it securely.

6.2 Cleaning the Machine Exterior

- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as they may damage the finish.

6.3 Drain Pipe Care

- Periodically check the drain pipe for blockages or kinks.
- Ensure it is always positioned correctly for efficient drainage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues, refer to the table below for common problems and their solutions. If the problem persists, contact customer service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not start	No power supply; Lid not closed properly	Check power plug and outlet; Ensure lid is fully closed
Poor washing performance	Overloading; Insufficient detergent; Incorrect program selection	Reduce load size; Use recommended detergent amount; Select appropriate wash program
Excessive vibration/noise	Uneven load; Machine not level; Foreign objects in tub	Rearrange clothes evenly; Adjust leveling feet; Check and remove any foreign objects
Water not draining	Drain pipe kinked or blocked; Drain selector set incorrectly	Straighten drain pipe, clear blockages; Turn 'Drain Selector' to 'Drain'
