Technical Safety

- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

4 SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- Ventilation openings must not be obstructed by a carpet.
- This appliance is intended to be used in household only.
- Use a new hose or hose-set supplied with the appliance. Reusing old hoses can cause a water leak and subsequent property damage.
- The inlet water pressure must be less than 100 kPa.

Installation

- Never attempt to operate the appliance if it is damaged, malfunctioning, partially disassembled, or has missing or broken parts, including a damaged cord or plug.
- This appliance should only be transported by two or more people holding the appliance securely.
- Do not install the appliance in a damp and dusty place. Do not install or store the appliance in any outdoor area, or any area that is subject to weathering conditions such as direct sunlight, wind, rain, or temperatures below freezing.
- Make sure the power plug is completely pushed into the power outlet.
- Do not plug the appliance into multiple outlet sockets or an extension power cable.
- Do not modify the power plug provided with the appliance. If it does not fit the power outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician.
- This appliance must be grounded. In the event of malfunction or breakdown, grounding will reduce the risk of electric shock by providing a path of least resistance for electric current.
- This appliance is equipped with a power cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding power plug. The power plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet socket that is installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.
- Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in risk of electric shock. Check with a qualified electrician or service personnel if you are in doubt as to whether the appliance is properly grounded.
- Tighten and secure the drain hose at connecting ends to avoid separation.

Operation

- Do not attempt to separate any panels or disassemble the appliance.

6 SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not repair or replace any part of the appliance. All repairs and servicing must be performed by qualified service personnel unless specifically recommended in this Owner's Manual. Use only authorized factory parts.
- Do not leave the appliance door open. Children may hang on the door or crawl inside the appliance, causing damage or injury.
- Do not put in, wash or dry articles that have been cleaned in, washed in, soaked in, or spotted with combustible or explosive substances (such as waxes, wax removers, oil, paint, gasoline, degreasers, drycleaning solvents, kerosene, petrol, spot removers, turpentine, vegetable oil, cooking oil, acetone, alcohol, etc.). Improper use can cause fire or explosion.
- Do not use or store flammable or combustible substances (ether, benzene, alcohol, chemical, LPG, combustible spray, insecticide, air freshener, cosmetics, etc.) near the appliance.
- Do not place flammable objects (such as candles, lamps, etc.) or heating devices (such as stoves, heaters, etc.) on the appliance.
- Never reach into the appliance while it is operating. Wait until the drum has completely stopped.
- In case of a water leak from the appliance, disconnect the power plug and contact the LG Electronics customer information centre.
- Turn off water taps to relieve pressure on hoses and valves and to minimize leakage if a break or rupture should occur. Check the condition of the fill hoses; they may need replacement after 5 years.
- If there is a gas leakage (isobutane, propane, natural gas, etc.) within the home, do not touch the appliance or power plug and ventilate the area immediately.
- If the drain hose or inlet hose is frozen during winter, use it only after thawing.
- Keep all washing detergents, softener and bleach away from children.
- Do not touch the power plug or the appliance controls with wet hands.
- Do not bend the power cable excessively or place a heavy object on it.

- Wipe off dirt or dust on the contacts of the power plug.
- Do not fill the washing machine with more than 50 °C water. It may deform plastic parts or cause malfunctions.
- Do not drain water from the wash tub while the spin tub is operating.
- Always unplug the power cord after use.
- During washing spinning and drain, check that drain hose is lowered.

Maintenance

- Disconnect the appliance from the power supply before cleaning the appliance. Setting the controls to the OFF or stand by position does not disconnect this appliance from the power supply.
- Securely plug the power plug in the outlet socket after completely removing any moisture and dust.
- Do not spray water inside or outside the appliance to clean it.
- Never unplug the appliance by pulling on the power cable. Always grip the power plug firmly and pull straight out from the outlet socket.
- Only qualified service personnel from LG Electronics service centre should disassemble, repair, or modify the appliance. Contact an LG Electronics customer information centre if you move and install the appliance in a different location.

Disposal

- Before discarding an old appliance, unplug it. Cut off the cable directly behind the appliance to prevent misuse.
- Dispose of all packaging materials (such as plastic bags and styrofoam) away from children. The packaging materials can cause suffocation.

- Insert the power cord plug into the power socket-outlet. Use 3 pin socket only with proper earthing.

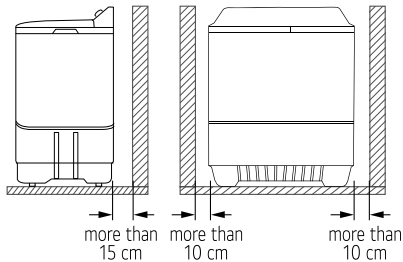

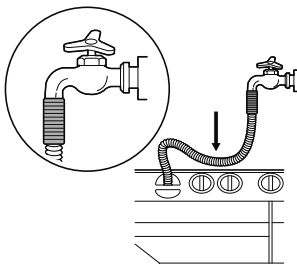
- For placing & leveling the machine
 - Select flat & firm floor.



- Maintain more than 15cm gap between the side of drain hose and the wall.



- The base openings must not be obstructed by carpeting when the washing machine is installed on a carpeted floor.
- Fix the Inlet hose (kept inside the accessory bag).



- For drain hose fixing method and positioning (Refer Installing the Drain Hose Guide).

NOTE

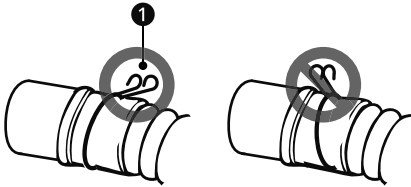
- The machine has mobility function by manual intervention, care to be taken to avoid any body parts coming under wheels.
- Install the washing machine on a horizontal support. Otherwise, it may cause vibration and noise.
- Incorrect installation may cause severe noise and break down.
- Rat away is a way to reduce damage caused by specific categories of rats and may not be effective on all rodents. Actual results may vary depending on actual product use conditions.

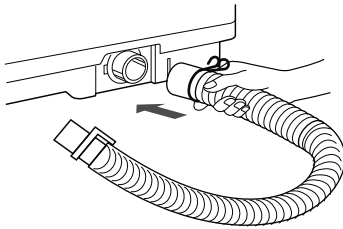
Before connecting the drain hose, check your drain hose model and follow the instructions for that model.

Installing the Drain Hose

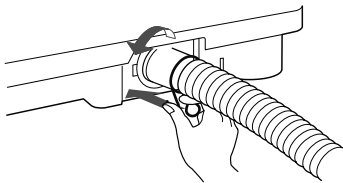
- 1 Fix the snap ring ① to the drain hose.



- 2 Align the drain hose with drain outlet



- 3 Press hose clip and push the hose towards the body of the washing machine and release the snap ring.

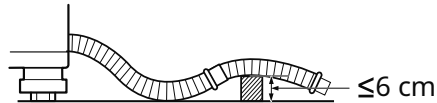
- Be sure to re-route the drain hose so that it is not kinked or has sharp bends which will prevent proper drainage.
- Use only new hose set provided with the machine.

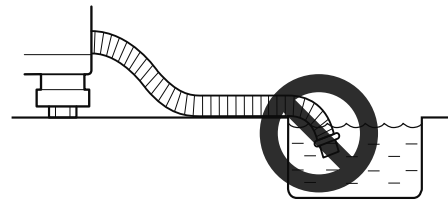
- Packaging materials (such as plastic bags and thermocol) should be kept away from children.

Positioning the Drain Hose

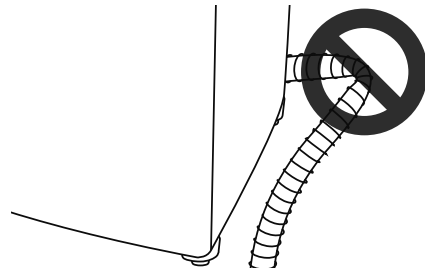
- Always keep the level of drain hose slightly lower than the lowest part of the washing machine.
- Make sure the drain hose should remain straight.
- Do not place the drain hose more than 6 cm above the floor.



- The outlet of the drain hose should not be submerged in water.



- Do not crush hose. Make sure to maintain gap of more than 15cm between the side of drain hose and the wall.
- Make sure the drain hose is not kinked.



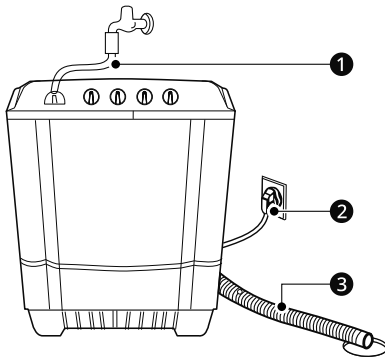

OPERATION

Preparing the Wash Load

Sort the wash load for best washing results, and then prepare the clothes according to the symbols on their care labels.

Preparing



- Connect the water supply hose ① to the water supply inlet.
- Connect the power cord ② to the electrical outlet.
- Always keep the level of drain hose ③ slightly lower than the lowest part of the washing machine.
- Use new inlet hose available with machine.
- Set the water selector lever to **WASH** for washing/rinsing & to **SPIN** for interim spin rinse.

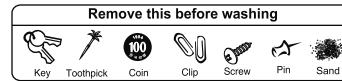
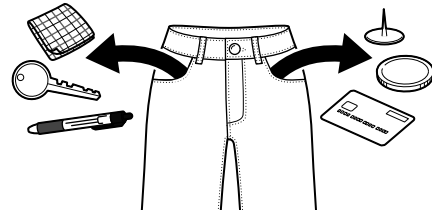
- The water selector lever should not be placed near the center otherwise water flows to the wash and spin tub simultaneously.



- For your convenience hang up the wash cover on the left side of the washing machine tub when not in use.

Checking the clothes before Washing

- Check the washing instructions labels on the clothing to be washed.
- Don't forget to remove any objects from the pockets of the clothing. Object left in the pockets will damage the clothing or washing machine (especially cause clogging of the drain hose).

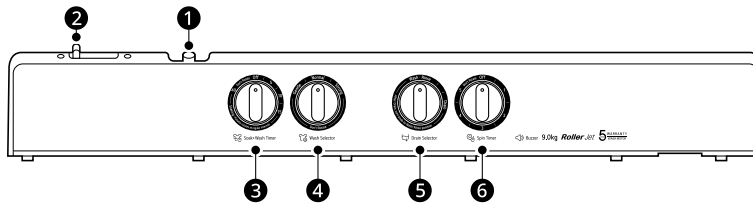


- Start washing after separating an oiled or dye laundry.

Control Panel and Functions

1 Water Supply Inlet

- Connect here with the Inlet hose from the water tap to feed water to the tub.

2 Water Selector

- Select **WASH** to supply water for washing and rinsing and **SPIN** for spin shower rinse.

3 Soak + Wash Timer

- The **Wash Timer** can be used for soak, wash and rinse operations. Select the desired time for soak, wash and rinse following the below combinations.

- 1) Soak+Wash : Select the desired soak time by setting the timer between 15~35/40 min then total wash time will be selected soak time + 15 min of wash time

35 min Soak Timer : 20 min Soak + 15 min Wash, **40 min Soak Timer** : 25 min Soak + 15 min Wash

- 2) Wash/Rinse : Any Wash/Rinse time 1~15 min can be selected by setting the timer between 1~15 min. Washing will take place for the set period, then machine stops automatically.
- 3) In Soak option, machine operates for 1~2 min & remains off for 5 min. This cycle continues for selected soak time.

Soak Function : Soaking is provided for better cleaning of clothes as detergent water goes to inner pores of clothing resulting dirt removal in better way.

4 Wash Selector

- Set the selector to **Gentle**, **Normal**, **Strong** according to kinds and quantity of the laundry.

5 Drain Selector

- Select **Wash.Rinse** for washing and rinsing, and **Drain** to drain the water from the tub.

6 Spin Timer

- Turn the timer to select the desired spinning time.
- Don't rotate the knob more than prescribed limit.

- Please do not match this figure with model as it may be different from your model, these are schematic diagram only.

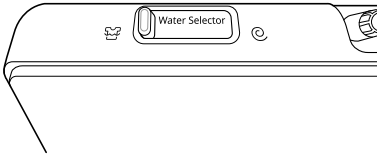

- 1 Set the **Drain Selector** to **Wash.Rinse** position.



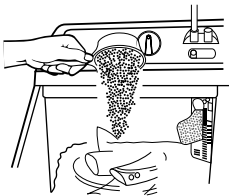

- 2 Set the **Water Selector** to **WASH**.



- 3 Open the water tap and fill water in the wash tub about halfway to the desired water level.

- 4 For models without detergent box
 - Put the appropriate amount of detergent and the laundry into the wash tub and add water to the required level.



- 5 Select the **Wash Selector** to **Gentle**, **Normal**, **Strong** according to kinds and quantity of the laundry.



Wash Selector

- 6 Set the desired wash time.



Soak + Wash Timer

- 7 When washing is finished, select the **Drain Selector** to **Drain** position and drain the water out.



Drain Selector

⚠ CAUTION

- Washing machine is provided with different water level selection options for washing and rinsing processes such as, L (Low), M (Medium), H (High). H represents the Maximum water level available.
 - Fill the adequate water quantity as per the laundry load so that clothes can absorb the required amount of water and water will not be short.

Rinsing

Continuous water supply rinse

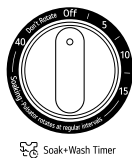
The course is to rinse while feeding water continuously.

- 1 Select the **Drain Selector** to **Wash.Rinse** position.



- 2 Put the laundry into the wash tub and open the water tap.

- 3 Set the rinse time with the **Wash Timer** and feed water continuously.

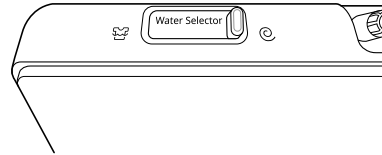


Interim spin rinse

Interim spin rinse prior to regular rinsing will remove sudsy water from the laundry and improve rinsing efficiency.

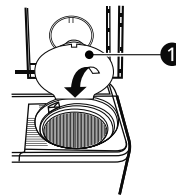
- 1 After washing
 - Put the laundry into the spin dryer basket.
 - Place the safety cover horizontally on the laundry.

- 2 Set the **Water Selector** to **SPIN** and open the tap.

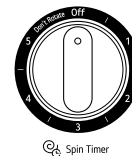


- 3 Supply water for about 1 minute. Adjust the water flow to prevent overflow from the wash tub.

- 4 Turn off the water supply close the safety cover-1 ① and spin dryer cover.



- 5 Set the desired spin time with the **Spin Timer**.



- 6 After spinning, put the laundry into the wash tub and rinse.

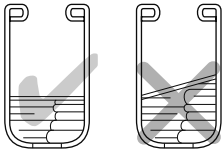

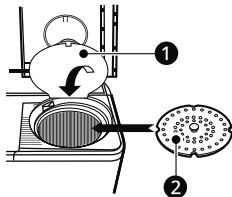

Spinning

- 1 Put the laundry evenly into the spin dryer basket.
 - Transfer the clothes from wash tub to spin dryer basket one by one.
- 2 Put the laundry down lightly.
- 3 Place the safety cover ② horizontally on the top of the laundry inside the basket.



- 4 Close the safety cover-1 ① and then spin dryer cover.



- 5 Set the **Spin Timer**.

Spin Time Guide

Type of clothing	Spin Time
Thin fabrics (synthetic fabrics, mixed fabrics) / Sweaters	1 min
Silk (synthetic fabrics)	1 - 3 min
Cotton underwear	3 - 5 min
Sheets / Towels	5 - 10 min

- Do not drain the water out of the wash tub while the spin dryer basket is in operation. Otherwise the spin motor could be damaged.
- If the spin dryer basket is off- balance and vibrates excessively, stop the spinning, rearrange the clothes evenly, and then resume spinning.
- If the spinning fail to stop when the spin dryer cover is opened, the brake is out of order. Immediately stop using the machine and request repair service.

NOTE

- For wollen clothes, spin for 1 min only for clothes protection.

CAUTION

- Do not continue Spin over 3 consecutive cycles. After 3 consecutive spin cycles, stop spinning more then 1 hour. Spin motor may stop operation or may be damaged.

After Finishing Wash

- 1 Remove the laundry from the spin dryer basket and close the spin dryer cover.
- 2 If there is water in the wash tub, set the **Drain Selector** to **Drain** in order to drain it out.
- 3 Disconnect the power cord from the electrical outlet.
- 4 Clean the washing machine.

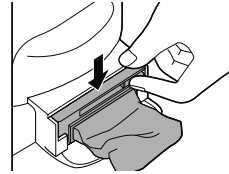
Cleaning after Every Wash

Washing Machine

If the washing machine itself becomes dirty.

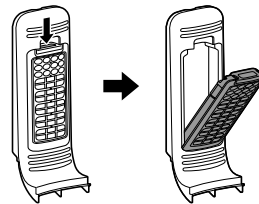
- The washing machine can be cleaned with cloth soaked in mild liquid detergent. Never use abrasive cleaner or chemical such as benzene or thinner to clean washing machine, because these materials will damage the plastic parts.

- 3 Fit the filter to its original position. Press the filter until you hear a click sound.



Smart Filter

- 1 Push down release tab given on up side and pull forward.

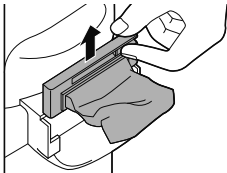

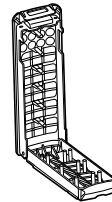

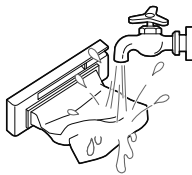
- 1 Pull out lint filter.



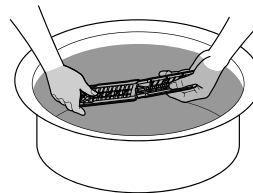
- 2 Open the lid and remove the lint.



- 2 Turn the net over and rinse in water.

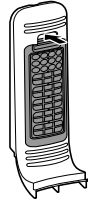


- 3 Wash the filter.

- 4 Close the lid and then insert the lower part of the filter. Press the top of the filter until you hear a click sound.



- 4 After 15 minutes wash, rotate the **Drain Selector** knob from **Wash.Rinse** to **Drain** and again back to **Wash.Rinse** position. Repeat this process 5-7 times. This will remove scaling.

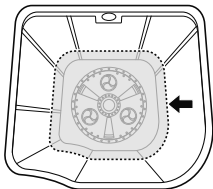

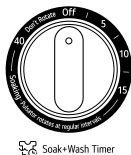
- 1 Keep **Drain Selector** knob at **Wash.Rinse** position.



- 2 Fill 1-2 buckets of warm water (temperature less than 50 °C) in wash tub.



- 3 Select wash time for 15 minutes and operate. Do not put detergent powder or cloth in the machine.



Caring the Appliance

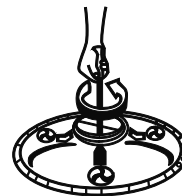
Pulsator

If a button or some other object gets caught in the pulsator.

- 1 Take out the pulsator cap with "-" type screw driver.



- 2 Use a screwdriver to unscrew the screw in the center of the pulsator and lift the pulsator straight up in order to remove the button or other object.



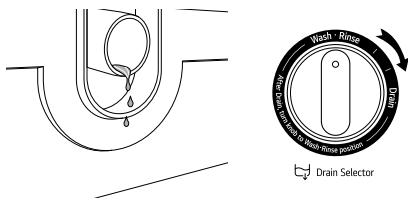
- 3 Place the pulsator at its original position and tighten the screw.

- 4 Place the pulsator cap at its original position.

Water Leakage

In case water leakage is observed, rotate **Drain Selector** 5-7 times. By doing so, any obstructed foreign particle will drain off.

- Perform the above steps again, till the problem is resolved.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before Calling for Service

Operation of the appliance can lead to errors and malfunctions. The following tables contain possible causes and notes for resolving an error message or malfunction. You can remedy most of the problems by yourself, consequently save time and money, since you do not need to call LG Electronics service centre. The following table should assist you by troubleshooting.

Operation

Symptoms	Possible Cause & Solution
Appliance will not operate.	Appliance is unplugged. Make sure that the cord is plugged securely into a working outlet.
	Controls are not set properly. Make sure the Wash Timer knob or the Spin Timer knob is not in the "0" position.
Appliance will not drain water.	Drain hose is kinked. Ensure that the drain hose is not kinked.
	Drain is located higher than 1.0 m above the floor. Make sure that the drain hose is no higher than 1.0 m above the bottom of the appliance.
Rattling and clanking noise	Foreign objects, such as keys, coins, or safety pins may be in the drum. Stop the appliance, check the drum for foreign objects. If noise continues after the appliance is restarted, call for service.
Thumping sound	Heavy laundry may produce a thumping sound. This is usually normal. If the sound continues, the appliance is probably out of balance. Stop and redistribute the laundry.
	The laundry may be out of balance. Pause the cycle and redistribute the laundry.
Vibrating noise	The laundry may be unevenly distributed in the drum. Pause the cycle and redistribute the laundry.

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Warranty and Service Information

WARRANTY

The Washing Machine (hereinafter referred as product) comes with 2 year warranty on all parts (except Plastic parts, Consumables, Loose Plastic Parts, Filters, Knobs, Top covers, Inlet/outlet hose) and thereafter a 3 years additional warranty only on the wash motor from the date of purchases on producing the tax paid invoice of the product provided always that the warranty card bears the rubber stamp, date and signature of our authorized dealer.

3 YEAR ADDITIONAL WARRANTY ON THE WASH MOTOR

The 3 Year warranty on the Wash Motor will continue even after the expiry of 2 year period from the date of purchase. During the additional warranty period, it does not cover parts such as Controller Assembly, Timers, Spin motor, Tub assembly, etc. The standard visiting charges will be applicable within municipal limit of town where LG Electronics India Ltd. (LGEIL) has its Authorized Service Centre. Service Outside municipal limit will attract to and fro travelling, other incidental expense in addition to standard visiting charges, as per the prevailing from time to time. During the additional warranty period only the parts replaced or repaired shall be free of costs, but service charges shall always be payable by the customer.

COMMON TERMS & CONDITIONS APPLICABLE FOR WARRANTIES AS MENTIONED ABOVE

- 1) The warranty is confined to the first purchaser of the washing machine only & is non-transferable.
- 2) Repairs & replacements will be carried out through the Authorized Service Centres of LG Electronics India Ltd. (hereinafter referred as LG or LGEIL). The customer may place their service call through the LG customer care or through the dealer from whom the product has been purchased. In case the customer shifts the place of residence during the warranty period, it is advised to contact our helpline.
- 3) Repairs under warranty shall be carried out by an authorized service personnel only. The details of centralized help lines are attached.
- 4) For units installed beyond municipal limits of the jurisdiction of the company's Authorized Service Centre, it is the responsibility of the purchaser to contact the nearest authorized service centre and bring the unit to the authorized service at its own cost and risk. All expense incurred in collecting the units or parts thereof from the company's authorized service centre, as well as expenses incurred with deputing of service personnel/technician toward conveyance and other incidentals etc. will be borne by the customer. Local charges for transportation and handling charges may vary from location to location. Customers are advised to verify before. In case the customer desires to bring the unit on its own to the Authorized Service Centre, the same shall be at its own risks & consequences.
- 5) The concerned authorized service centre will advise the customer whether to effect the repairs at site or at the authorized service centre.
- 6) Call registered with the centralized helpline/Authorized service centre, wherein only cleaning of the unit/parts in the unit due to dust accumulation on portions of the units are not to be considered as defects.
- 7) In case of repairs or replacement of any part/s of the unit, this warranty will thereafter continue and remain in force only for the unexpired period of the warranty. LGEIL may use parts that are new or refurbished and equivalent to new in performance and reliability. Replacement of parts would be purely at the discretion of LGEIL alone. In case the replacement of the entire unit is being made, (subject to the sole discretion of LGEIL), the same model shall be replaced and in the event such model has been discontinued, it shall be replaced with the model price equivalent at the time of purchase.
- 8) In case of any damage to the product/customer abuse/repairs by un-authorized personnel's/ misuse detected/ by the Authorized Service Centre personnel, the warranty conditions are not applicable and repairs will be done subject to availability of parts and on a chargeable basis only.
- 9) This warranty shall not cover any consequential or resulting liability, damage or loss to property or life arising directly or indirectly out of any defect being noticed in the equipment during the warranty

period of the Washing Machine. The company's obligation under this warranty shall be limited to repair or providing replacement of defective parts only under the warranty period.

- 10) The company or its Authorized Service Centre reserves the right to retain any part/s or component replaced its discretion, in the event of defect being noticed in the equipment during warranty period.
- 11) While the company will make every effort to carry out repairs at the earliest, it however is made expressly clear that the company is under no obligation to do so in a specified period of time.
- 12) Warranty does not cover accessories external to the equipment supplied by the dealer.
- 13) In the event of any unforeseen circumstance, and spares not being available, the company's prevailing depreciation rules may apply on the purchaser to accept as a commercial solution in lieu of repairs.
- 14) If any coloured internal or external components are replaced, there will be no commitment to ensure that the shades match with the original or other components. The replaced shades, patterns, tints may vary from the customer's unit due to continuous usage of the unit. Any matching components changed at customer's request will be chargeable basis, except the component which actually needed.
- 15) Free Installation or Demo of the product, can be availed only once & within 3 months from the date of purchase.
- 16) Any extended warranty offered by LGEIL has to be supported by relevant proof.
- 17) Warranty shall expire after the warranty period as mentioned above even if the Washing Machine may not be in use for any time during the warranty period for any reason.
- 18) Only courts in state of Delhi and places where LGEIL has its branch office shall have the jurisdiction for settling any claims, disputes arising under the warranty.

Warranty is not applicable in any of the following cases :

- 1) The warranty card is not completed properly at the time of purchase.
- 2) The completed warranty card is not presented to authorized service personnel at the time of service of the product.
- 3) The product is not operated according to instructions given in the Operating Instruction Booklet / Owner's Manual.
- 4) The product is used for commercial purposes.
- 5) The product is used at any places such as public bathroom, lodging house, training center, dormitory etc.
- 6) The product has failed under certain conditions like waterlogging, flood, fire, misuse etc.
- 7) Defects/malfunction are caused by improper or reckless use, which shall be determined by the company personnel.
- 8) Any repair work is carried out by persons other than authorized service personnel.
- 9) Defect/malfunction are caused which are beyond control like lightening, abnormal voltage, Acts of God, virus etc.
- 10) Any issue is caused by usage of 3rd party product like voltage stabilizer, power outlet socket, MCB, extension board etc.
- 11) Defects/malfunction caused while in transit to service centre or purchaser's residence.
- 12) Defects caused by rodents bite or by pests and vermin ants/Insects/animals/birds etc.
- 13) The serial number is deleted, defected or altered.
- 14) Damage is caused to the product or any part/s due to transportation or shifting.

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- 15) Any accessory external to the equipment are supplied by dealer or LG.
