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Apple AirTag (2nd Generation) User Manual

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1. INTRODUCTION

The Apple AirTag (2nd Generation) is a compact, battery-powered device designed to help you locate your personal items using Apple's Find My network. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your AirTag.

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2. SETUP

Setting up your AirTag is a simple, one-tap process that integrates seamlessly with your Apple devices.

1. **Unpack the AirTag:** Remove the AirTag from its packaging.
2. **Activate:** Pull the tab to activate the battery. The AirTag will play a sound to indicate it's active.
3. **Pair with iPhone/iPad:** Hold the AirTag near your iPhone or iPad. A setup animation will appear on your device's screen.
4. **Follow On-Screen Instructions:** Tap "Connect" and follow the prompts to name your AirTag and register it to your Apple ID.
5. **Attach to Item:** Once paired, attach the AirTag to the item you wish to track (e.g., keys, bag, wallet).

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System Requirements: To use AirTag, your iPhone or iPad must be running iOS 14, iPadOS, or macOS Catalina or later, and you must be signed in to iCloud with your Apple Account.

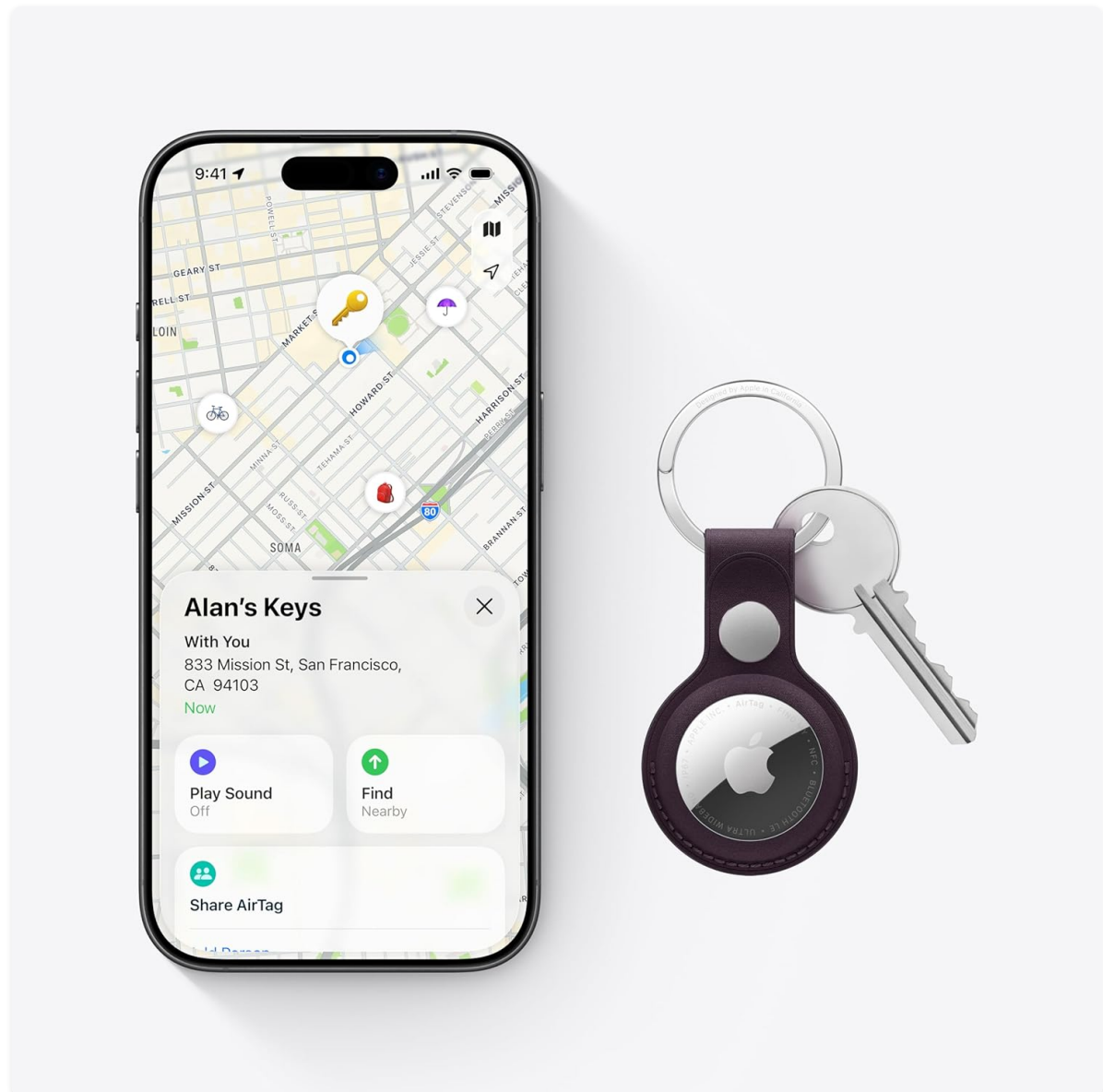


Image 2.1: An iPhone screen showing the Find My app interface, with an AirTag attached to a set of keys nearby, illustrating the pairing

3. OPERATING YOUR AIRTAG

The AirTag utilizes the Find My network to help you locate your items.

3.1 Using the Find My App

Open the Find My app on your iPhone, iPad, or Mac. Navigate to the "Items" tab to see all your AirTags and their last known locations on a map.

3.2 Precision Finding

For closer proximity, use Precision Finding. If your iPhone or Apple Watch supports it (iPhone 15 or later, Apple Watch Series 9 or later), you will receive visual, haptic, and audio feedback to guide you directly to your AirTag.

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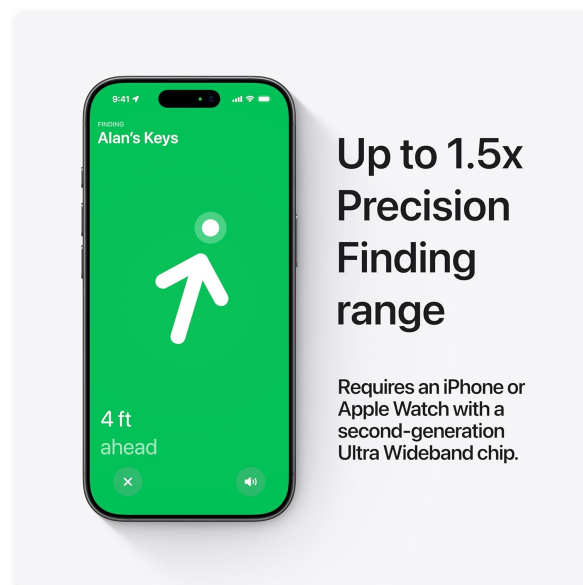


Image 3.1: An iPhone displaying the Precision Finding feature, showing an arrow and distance to guide the user to their AirTag.

3.3 Playing a Sound

If your AirTag is nearby but out of sight, you can play a sound through its enhanced speaker. The 2nd Generation AirTag features a 50% louder speaker and a distinctive chime, making it easier to hear.

3.4 Sharing Location

You can temporarily and securely share your AirTag's location access with trusted contacts or third parties through the Find My app.

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Your AirTag's location is private. Only you or authorized users can see its location, and your location data and history are never stored on the AirTag itself. Apple's Find My network is encrypted and anonymous.

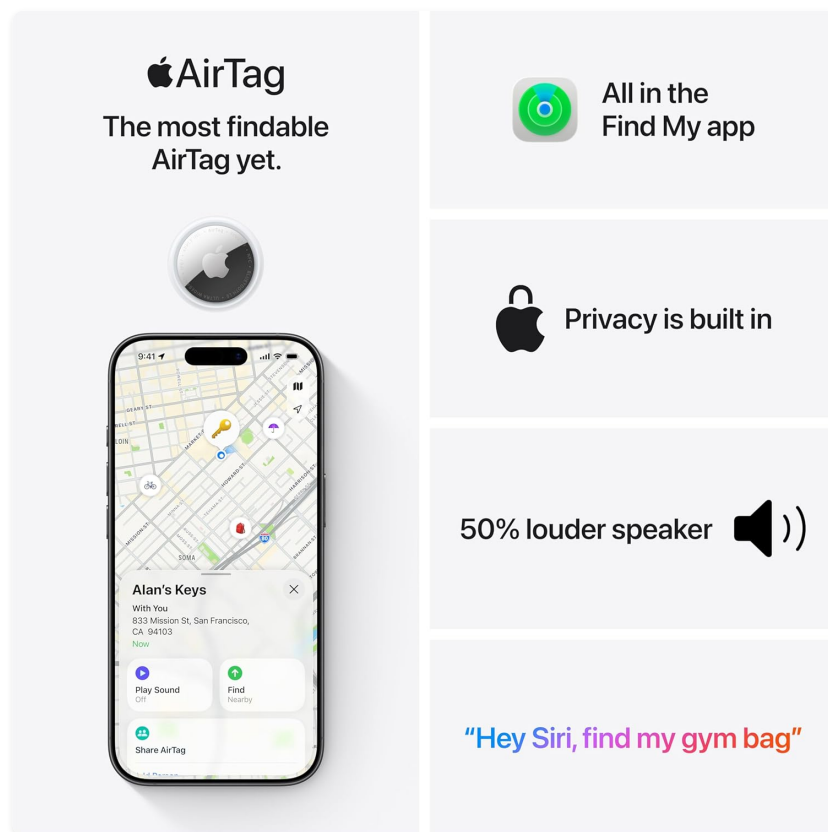


Image 3.2: A visual summary of key AirTag features, highlighting its integration with the Find My app, privacy features, enhanced speaker, and Siri compatibility.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Battery Replacement

The AirTag (2nd Generation) uses a standard, user-replaceable battery that typically lasts for more than a year. Your iPhone will alert you when the battery needs replacement.

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1. **Twist the Back Cover:** Press down on the polished stainless steel battery cover of the AirTag and rotate it counterclockwise until it stops.
2. **Remove Old Battery:** Lift off the cover and remove the old CR2032 lithium 3V coin cell battery.
3. **Insert New Battery:** Insert a new CR2032 battery with the positive (+) side facing up.
4. **Replace Cover:** Place the cover back on, aligning the three tabs on the cover with the three slots on the AirTag.
5. **Twist to Secure:** Press down on the cover and rotate it clockwise until it locks into place.

4.2 Cleaning

Wipe the AirTag with a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid using abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.

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5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **AirTag Not Connecting:**
 - Ensure your iPhone/iPad is running iOS 14/iPadOS or later.
 - Confirm you are signed into iCloud with your Apple ID.
 - Check if the AirTag battery is active and not depleted.
 - Try resetting the AirTag by removing and reinserting the battery five times, ensuring a chime sounds each time.
- **Precision Finding Not Working:**
 - Precision Finding requires an iPhone 15 or later, or an Apple Watch Series 9 or later (with watchOS 26.2.1).
 - Ensure Ultra Wideband is enabled and not restricted in your region.
 - Check for physical obstructions between your device and the AirTag.
- **Sound Not Playing or Too Quiet:**
 - Verify the AirTag battery level.
 - Ensure the AirTag is not submerged in water or heavily muffled.

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- **Location Not Updating:**
 - Ensure the AirTag is within range of an Apple device on the Find My network.
 - Check your device's internet connection.
