- Keep the iron out of reach of children and pets when hot or cooling down.
- Never leave the iron unattended while it is connected to the power supply.
- Use the iron only for its intended purpose: ironing clothes.
- Do not operate the iron with a damaged cord or plug, or if the iron has been dropped or damaged. Contact customer support for repair.
- Always unplug the iron before filling or emptying the water tank, and when not in use.
- Place the iron on a stable, heat-resistant surface when resting.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.

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- **Soleplate:** Non-stick coated for smooth gliding.
- **Water Tank:** 200 ml capacity for steam generation.
- **Temperature Control Dial:** Adjusts heat for different fabric types.
- **Steam Slider/Button:** Controls steam output and vertical steaming.
- **Spray Nozzle:** For misting stubborn wrinkles.
- **Power Cord:** 360-degree swivel for flexible movement.

3. SETUP AND PREPARATION

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the iron from its packaging. Remove any labels or protective film from the soleplate before first use. Ensure all components, including the measuring cup, are present.

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3.2 Filling the Water Tank

1. Ensure the iron is unplugged and cool.
2. Set the steam slider to the '0' (dry ironing) position.
3. Open the water filler cap.
4. Using the provided measuring cup, slowly pour clean tap water into the water tank up to the 'MAX' fill line. Do not overfill.
5. Close the water filler cap securely.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 General Ironing Steps

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1. Sort clothes by fabric type and recommended ironing temperature.
2. Plug the iron into a suitable power outlet.
3. Set the temperature control dial to the desired fabric setting (e.g., Nylon, Silk, Wool, Cotton, Linen). The indicator light will illuminate.
4. Wait for the iron to heat up. The indicator light will turn off when the set temperature is reached.
5. Adjust the steam slider for steam ironing or keep it at '0' for dry ironing.
6. Begin ironing.

4.2 Steam Ironing

For steam ironing, ensure the water tank is filled and the temperature dial is set to a steam-appropriate setting (usually Cotton, Linen, or higher). The iron will produce up to 15g/min of continuous steam.

4.3 Vertical Steaming

The iron supports vertical steaming for hanging garments or drapes. Hold the iron vertically a few inches away from the fabric and press the steam button to release bursts of steam.

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Vertical & Horizontal Steaming

Removes wrinkles from hanging & delicate clothes.

4.4 Dry Ironing

For dry ironing, ensure the water tank is empty or the steam slider is set to '0'. Select the appropriate temperature for your fabric.

4.5 Spray Function

Press the spray button to release a fine mist of water, which helps to dampen stubborn creases for easier removal.



5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

5.1 Cleaning the Soleplate

After use, when the iron is cool, wipe the soleplate with a damp cloth and a non-abrasive cleaner if necessary. Do not use harsh scouring pads or metallic cleaners, as this can damage the non-stick coating.

5.2 Draining the Water Tank

After each steam ironing session, empty any remaining water from the tank to prevent mineral buildup. Unplug the iron, let it cool, open the filler cap, and invert the iron over a sink.

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5.3 Storage

Once the iron is completely cool and empty, store it upright on its heel rest in a dry, safe place. Wrap the 360-degree swivel cord neatly around the base or use the cord clip if available.

360 Degree Swivel Cord

Allows easy movements in all directions along with cord groove.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your iron, refer to the following table for common problems and solutions.

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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Iron does not heat up.	Not plugged in; power outage; faulty outlet; thermostat set too low.	Check power connection; test outlet; set temperature higher.
No steam or insufficient steam.	Water tank empty; temperature too low for steam; steam slider set to '0'; mineral buildup.	Fill water tank; set temperature to steam-appropriate level; move steam slider; descale iron.
Water leakage from soleplate.	Temperature too low for steam; overfilled water tank; iron left horizontal when hot.	Increase temperature; do not overfill; store iron upright when hot.
Iron sticks to fabric.	Temperature too high for fabric; soleplate dirty.	Reduce temperature; clean soleplate.
