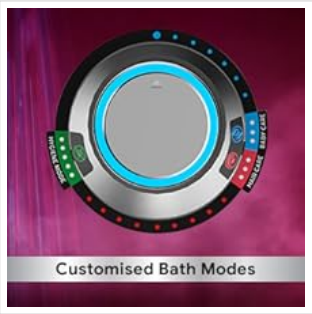


Image: Close-up of the water heater highlighting its rust-proof plastic body.

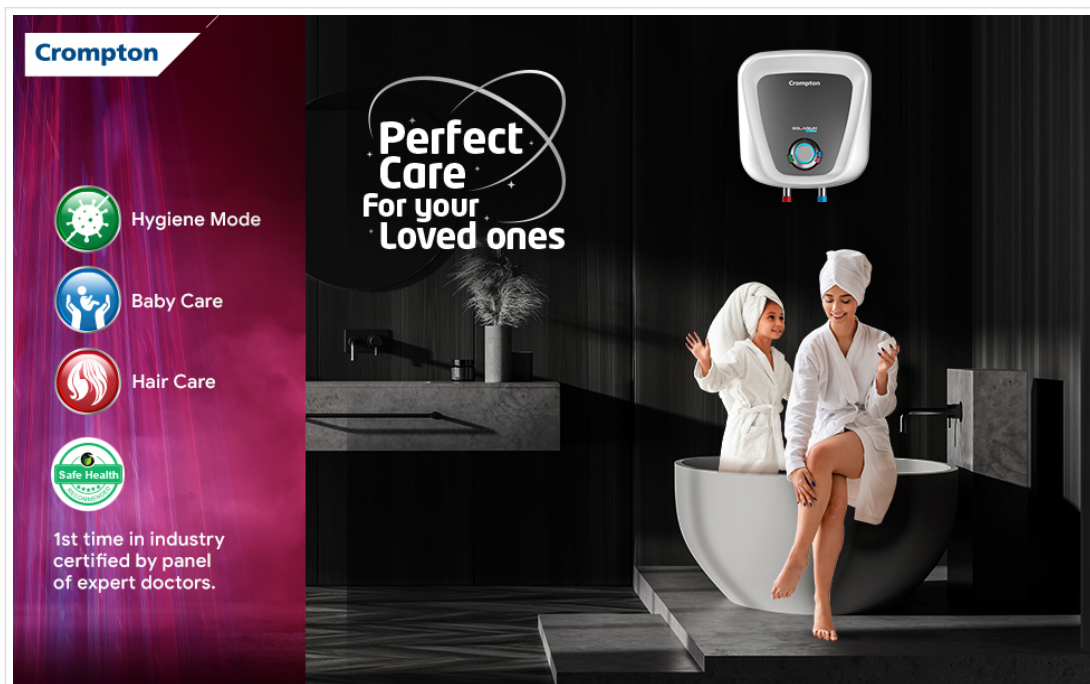


Image: Water Heater Buying Guide, illustrating recommended capacities for instant and storage geysers based on family size and intended use.

- **Pressure Release Valve:** Regularly check the pressure release valve for proper operation.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No hot water	Power supply off, thermostat tripped, heating element failure	Check power, reset thermostat, contact service
Water not hot enough	Thermostat setting too low, mineral buildup, faulty element	Adjust thermostat, descale (service), contact service
Water leaking	Loose connections, faulty pressure relief valve, tank corrosion	Tighten connections, replace valve (service), contact service
Unusual noise	Sediment buildup in tank, loose parts	Flush tank (service), check for loose parts
